ABOUT THE SEMINAR

This conference is intended to encourage interdisciplinary research among the students, teachers and research scholars. It aims to mark a significant turning point in our understanding and perspective about the different dimensions of gender equality at various levels and divergent subjects.

Political participation, level of availability of education, representation in decision making bodies, etc are some indicators of status of women in the society however the patriarchal norms of the society restrict women's employment choices.

In India women constitute nearly half (50%) of its population and around (40%) of labour force but when it comes to percentage of women in decision making units it is only 10%.

Therefore the conference aims to highlight and synthesize the information on the issues that are pulling back women from involving in policy making and implementation.

It also examines constraints on gender equality and tries to suggest the measures to increase their percentage in decision making positions.

The specific objectives of the seminar are

1. To understand the role of women in policy making and implementation
2. To analyze the share of percentage of women in decision making positions
3. To study the policies and initiatives that aims to increase the gender equality
4. To discuss the barriers that are responsible for women's low participation in policy making and implementation

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

Pingle Govt. College for Women owes its existence to the generosity of the Pingle family backed by their donation of the land and building. The donors include late Sri Pingle Venkatrama Reddy, the Dy. Prime Minister of the State of Nizam and his two brothers late Sri Pingle Krishna Reddy and late Sri Pingle Ranga Reddy. The building was handed over on 16-08-1965 to the Government for establishing an institution of higher learning to be named after Pingle family. All of us owe deep gratitude to the donor family.

The College which started with 67 students and 11 members of faculty & staff, witnessed continuous and all round development over the years. In 1966-67 the college saw the introduction of the degree courses in B.A. (H.P.P), B.A. (E.P.P.) and B.Sc. (B.Z.C) in both English and Telugu media with affiliation to Osmania University, Hyderabad. In 1978 the college was reaffiliated to Kakatiya University. In 1991 the Institution evolved into a multi-faculty institution. This College is the oldest Government Women's College in the State of Telangana. It presently has a strength of 1467 UG and 539 PG students. In the year 2021 college was sanctioned autonomous status by the UGC.

ABOUT THE CITY

The historic city of Warangal is a composite of three separate cities of Kazipet, Hanamkonda and Warangal which over a period of time has become one continuous city of Greater Municipal Corporation of Warangal. It is the second largest city in the State of Telangana. The college is located in Waddepally township in the Hanamkonda District of the Telangana State.
