



### Students' feedback Analysis:

- The majority of the 10 chosen parameters were regarded as "very good" by the students, according to their feedback.
- The students' feedback has been judiciously collected from all the disciplines.
- The parameter "How do you rate the Relevance of the course to the subject?" received the highest number of A's (Excellent).
- The highest number of D's (Average) were given to the parameter "How do you rate the

sequence of the units is the course?"

#### **Students' feedback Points of Satisfaction:**

- Students are satisfied that the course contents are relevant to the subject.
- They are contented with the availability of text book /study materials for the respective course/subjects.
- They expressed that the curriculum has a good blend of practical and theoretical features.
- The size of the curriculum is not stressful.

### Alumni feedback Points of Satisfaction:

- They said that the curriculum helped them improve their managerial and analytical skills and that it was useful in real-world situations.
- They stated that the design of the courses encouraged extra learning and they received more knowledge and abilities using various free internet platforms such as YouTube.

### Faculty feedback Points of Satisfaction:

- Many of the teachers consider that the size of syllabus in terms of load on the student is high and it should be reduced.
- Almost all faculty members opined that the sequence of units in the syllabus is good.
- They felt the objectives stated are relevant to the contents of the course.

### Action taken report

- Students were motivated to enroll themselves in MOOCS Spoken tutorial program and ٠ learn new computer languages and skills.
- Stakeholders have requested to start new UG programmes like applied nutrition and microbiology. Based on these, the following reuests have been communicated to CCE Telangana for favorable action.
  - to accord permission for new program in Food science for B.Sc. Life Sciences.
  - to remove Taxation and Business Analytics for B.Com students
  - to sanction BA Modern Language Telugu for BA TM
  - to sanction B.Com General EM & TM for B.Com Students.
    - In response to these requests, a new UG program in Applied nutrition for B.Sc. Life Sciences has been accorded
  - Departments were instructed to come up with new certificate courses to fill the gaps in the ۲ curriculum.

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
