- 7 to create awareness and ancient Indian astronomy and astrology

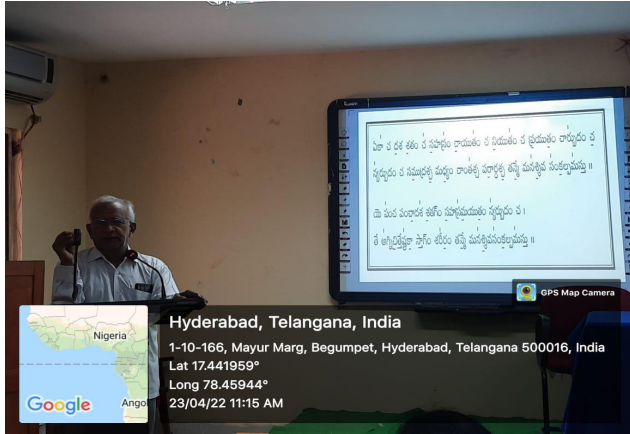
Inaugural session:

SESSION-1

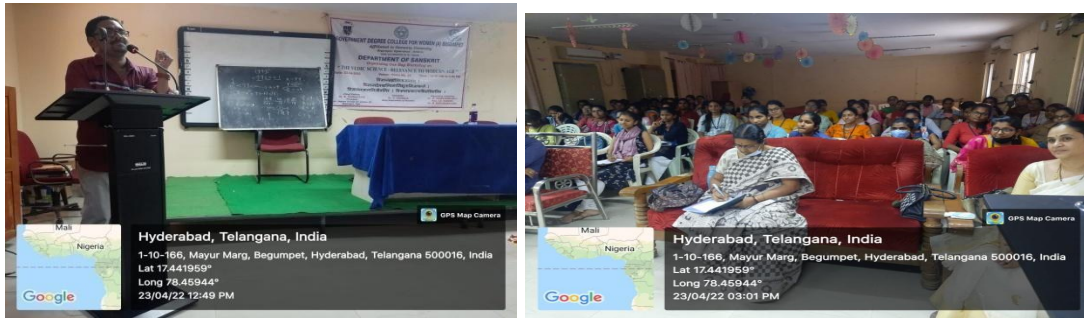

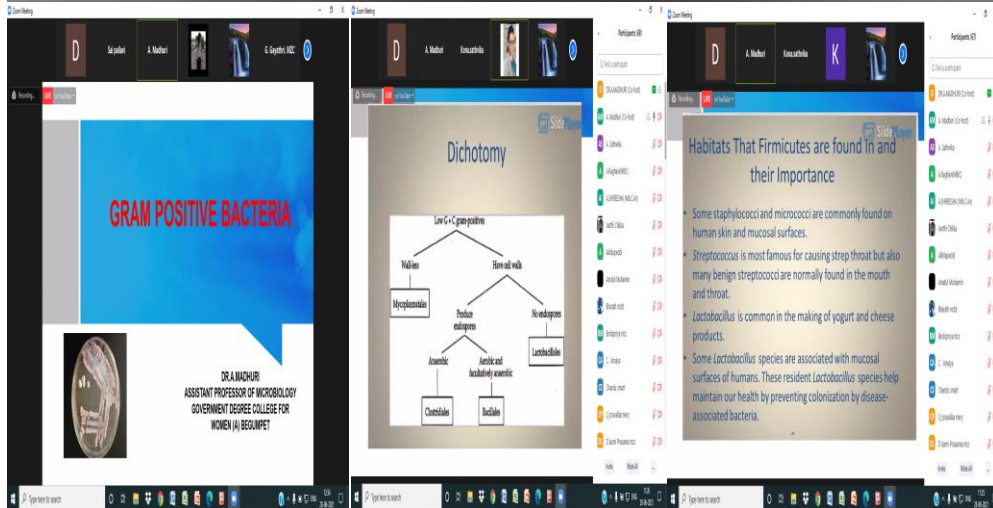
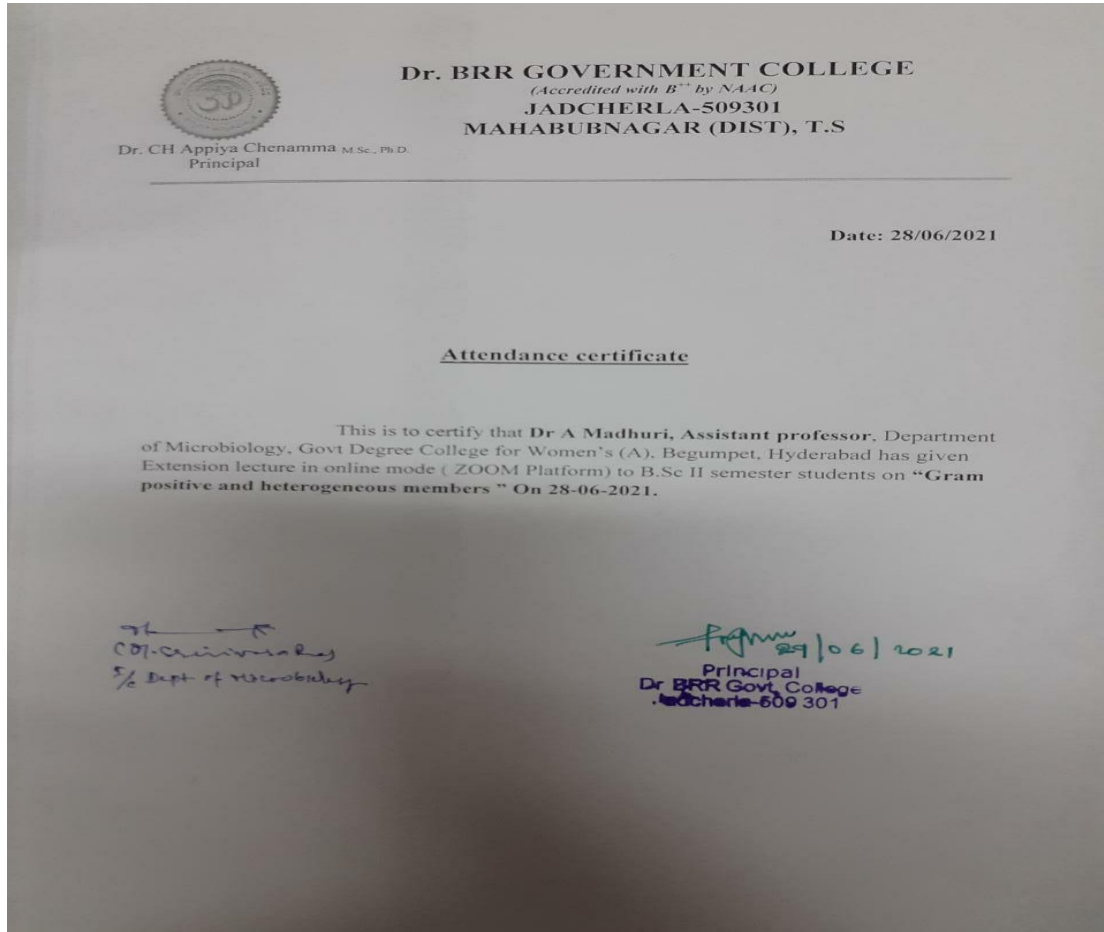
