Special Guest Ms.Uppala Tharuni , Corporator, Begumpet , guests, parents, dear colleagues and my dearest students, a very good morning to all of you.

The academic year 2016-17 began with new hopes and aspirations as we remain focused on our vision ‘Empowerment of Women through Knowledge’, and our commitment to the upliftment of women belonging to the marginalized sections of society. It is heartening to note that in its 46 years of journey towards excellence, the college is progressing from strength to strength in all its endeavors.

I consider it my privilege to inform you that, our college is the first Government College in the Telangna State to volunteer for the 3<sup>rd</sup> cycle of Accreditation by NAAC. The NAAC Peer Team visited the College on 29 & 30 & 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017 and we were awarded B+ grade. Recognizing the potential of the college, the University Grants Commission had conferred fresh autonomous status to the college in the academic year 2012-13 and the college is getting ready for second cycle of Autonomy Inspection in 2018-2019.

This year, the college has registered student strength of 1565 with 16 U.G. courses and 06 P.G. courses. The infrastructure in the college is conducive to the multifaceted courses that we offer. Our Library comprises of 22,000books, a Reading Room with e-corner, several Journals related to various subjects, Magazines and Newspapers. In the light of such academic and infrastructural facilities, we reiterate our commitment to our objective ‘Learning is the Best Ornament’, as we firmly believe that women empowerment alone can take the society to greater heights.

It gives me immense pleasure to share that the college has received Rs.2.00 Crores funding from Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) for renovation and Infrastructural development and is in full swing transforming the college as a center for teaching and learning.

The Telangana Skill Knowledge Centre (TSKC) in the college is a prestigious initiative of the State Government and our college has been identified as the nodal centre for TSKC activities. At the TSKC, students are given training in Computer Skills, Aptitude and Communication Skills to instill confidence in the students to face the selection process for various companies. This year 171 students underwent JKC training out of which 150 students were placed in various companies like Elico, ADP, GENPACT, ILM Pvt. Ltd, HDB Financial Services Ltd., Team-Viba, Transdyne, Aegis Ltd., Hinduja Global Solutions, Country Club, Real Shoppe, Care India in the placement drives held till now.

I am happy to announce that the pass percentage of the college has increased from 89% to 93% in the last Academic Year and we expect more this year.

- The College introduced 4 U.G. courses and 3 P.G. courses during this academic year .
- TSKC Curriculum on Employability Skills and Gender Sensitization Course was added to the 1<sup>st</sup> year Degree Course in semester I &II respectively for 1 credit each from this academic year(2016-2017).
- In addition to the languages and core subjects offered, the college has introduced 16 Trans-Disciplinary Electives in the academic year 2015-16. The syllabus and the evaluation pattern for these 16 electives were designed by the respective Departments. Under the CBCS pattern 100 hours of training spread over three years either in NCC / NSS / Sports / Martial Arts has been made mandatory for all students from the academic year 2014-15.
- I am happy to inform you that the college in its endeavor to strengthen the teaching learning process has introduced 17 Short Duration Certificate Courses for this academic year and the student's response to these courses has been overwhelming.  
The college brings out a magazine titled "**Reflections**". The college also has a newsletter **IN FOCUS** which covers the activities of the college from time to time.  
The staff and students of the college have been actively participating in the curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
- Our endeavor has always been to provide quality education to women students as education for girls and women is one of the most rewarding investments a nation can make.
- 'Reach Out' is a loving gesture by the teaching staff of our college through which financial assistance is given to needy students to pursue their education. This academic year 'Reach Out' helped to pay the tuition fee of 10 needy students who did not receive any scholarship. The Staff of college are also funding for refreshments for students for their Intensive Examination Preparations Program (IEPP), which is being conducted before end semester examinations.
- The College recognizes the importance of all the state holders and hence keeps in constant touch with them through Alumni meet and Parent Teacher meet every year.
- The College has the Grievance redressal cell / Internal Complaints committee to address the issues of Staff and Students.
- Recognizing our commitment of ensuring quality education, the UGC has sanctioned rupees two crores under RUSA grant ,with the help of which repair works were undertaken and additional four classrooms are being constructed.
