The academic year 2017-18 began with new hopes and aspirations as we remain focused on our vision 'Empowerment of Women through Knowledge', and our commitment to the upliftment of women belonging to the marginalized sections of society. It is heartening to note that in its 47 years of journey towards excellence, the college is progressing from strength to strength in all its endeavors. Telangana State formation Day was celebrated on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2017 with great enthusiasm by the Staff & Students. The Academic Audit by CCE was conducted on 13-06-2017 and we were awarded 'A' Grade.

This year, the college has registered student strength of 1702 with 16 U.G. courses and 06 P.G. courses. The infrastructure in the college is conducive to the multifaceted courses that we offer. Our Library comprises 22,000 books, a Reading Room with e-corner, several Journals related to various subjects, Magazines and Newspapers. In the light of such academic and infrastructural facilities, we reiterate our commitment to our objective 'Learning is the Best Ornament', as we firmly believe that women empowerment alone can take the society to greater heights.

It gives me immense pleasure to share that the college has received Rs.2.00 Crores funding from Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) for renovation and Infrastructural development and is in full swing transforming the college as a center for teaching and learning.

6 new classrooms are under construction with RUSA Funds. The RUSA funds have helped establish a Gym in college, strengthen the library and facilitated the creation of several digital classrooms.

4 new rooms and 2 mini Auditoriums were added this year with State Government R & B funds. We also received Rs.3.00 crores from the State Government for dismantling and construction of Administrative Block. An amount of Rs.50.00 Lakhs was received from MP LADS and Rs.45.00 lakhs from State Government towards construction of additional class rooms. Rs.30.00 Lakhs was received from the State Government towards construction of TSKC Hall.

The Telangana Skills & Knowledge Centre (TSKC) in the college is a prestigious initiative of the State Government and our college has been identified as the nodal centre for TSKC activities. The TSKC gives students training in Computer Skills, Aptitude and Communication Skills in all the 3 years to instill confidence in the students to face the selection process for various companies. This year all the students are underwent TSKC training out of which **107** final year students were placed in various companies like

GENPACT, ILM Pvt. Ltd, Aegis Ltd., Indigo Airlines, T.I.M.E, InnovSource, Karvy, Intelenet, Vespa, Varaunited, Saraswathi Vidya Mandir The placements are still in progress.

**I am happy to announce that the UG pass percentage of the college is 94% and the PG pass percentage is 95%.**

- TSKC Curriculum on Employability Skills, Gender Sensitization Course , HVPE were added to the Degree Course for I Credit each and have been integrated into the curriculum since 2016-17.
- In addition to the languages and core subjects offered, the college has introduced 16 Trans-Disciplinary Electives in the academic year 2015-16. The syllabus and the evaluation pattern for these 16 electives were designed by the respective Departments. Under the CBCS pattern 100 hours of training spread over three years either in NCC / NSS / Sports / Martial Arts has been made mandatory for all students from the academic year 2014-15.
- The College brings out a magazine titled **“Reflections”**. The college also has a newsletter **IN FOCUS** which covers the activities of the college from time to time.
- Our endeavor has always been to provide quality education to women students as education for girls and women is one of the most rewarding investments a nation can make.
- ‘Reach Out’ is a loving gesture by the teaching staff of our college through which financial assistance is given to needy students to pursue their education. This academic year ‘Reach Out’ helped to pay the tuition fee of 10needy students who did not receive any scholarship. The Staff of college are also funding for refreshments for students for their Intensive Examination Preparations Program (IEPP),which is being conducted before end semester examinations.
- The College recognizes the importance of all the state holders and hence keeps in constant touch with them through Alumni meet and Parent Teacher meet every year.
- The College has the Grievance redressal cell / Internal Complaints committee to address the issues of Staff and Students.
- An awareness programme on ANTI RAGGING and EVE TEASING is conducted by Anti-Ragging committee and Student Union committee every year to sensitize students .
