I also welcome all the special invitees, Parents, Colleagues, Gold Medal / Cash Prize sponsors, Press, ladies and gentlemen and dear students for the Annual Day Celebrations 2023 of GDCW Begumpet.

About the College:

Government Degree College for Women, Begumpet is a Premier Institution which offers quality education at tertiary level and stands as the first choice of many students in the state. The Institution caters to the diverse needs of girl students and is committed to provide quality education at low cost and no cost. Since its inception in 1971, it envisages the motto **Learning is the Best Ornament**. Various Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-curricular activities of the Institution reflect its vision “**Empowerment of Women through Knowledge.**” The Institution functions under the efficient guidance of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, which provides the required financial, academic and administrative guidance and assistance. Now, I would present a comprehensive report on the college activities for the academic year 2022-23.

- I consider it a privilege to lead this institution into progress; with constant support from the dignitaries in Higher Education Department, we, the staff and students of GDCWB strive for excellence.

- I am happy to inform you that the college has bagged All India 2nd Rank among the Government Autonomous Colleges across India, by Education World rankings for the AY 2023-24. The highest scores for this ranking were under the parameters of Curriculum and Pedagogy and Faculty Competence.
- The institution achieved A+ Grade, with 3.5 CGPA in the fourth cycle of NAAC, conducted on 22nd & 23rd August, 2022. GDCW, Begumpet is the first government degree college to achieve such a high score in the state of Telangana.
- The college got Autonomy Renewal in the second cycle during November 2021, which stands valid till 2024-25.
- Academic year 2021-22 was the Golden Jubilee year for the college, and the celebrations were culminated during August 2022.
- The college is part of the first Cluster of ten Colleges group formed by TSCHE, during November 2022.
- The Institution presently accommodates 3829 (UG 3462+367 PG) girl students altogether.
- Strength particulars 2022-23:
BA - 402, BBA - 180, B. Com - 1302, Life Sciences - 683, Physical Sciences - 895.
- The college offers 65 study programs (UG 59 + 6 PG) in the disciplines of Arts, Sciences, Commerce and Management,
- Based on the demands of the stakeholders, several Restructured Courses namely, BA (Honors), B. Sc (Gaming), BCA; Apprenticeship based courses BBA, E-Commerce were introduced in collaboration with Logistics Skill Council and Media Entertainment Council.
- The student intake for UG was 1500 and 1311 students were admitted into various courses for this AY.
- Student intake for PG for this AY was 360, out of which 221 students got admitted into the six PG courses offered by the college.
- Results for the Year 2022 are 94% for BA, 96% for B. Com, 95% for B.Sc. and 98% for BBA and the overall pass percentage for 2022 stands at 96%.
- For the AY 2021-22, 341 students of final year got selected to various companies like Reliance, IDBI/Apollo, TCS, Infosys, Cognizant, Accenture, Amazon etc.

Some of the Quality Initiatives taken up:

- NAANDI Foundation has established a skill centre in our college, which helps in training and placements, not only to our students, but also to other students in general, those who stay nearby our college. TSKC, placement cell of our college works in collaboration with NAANDI foundation and conducts trainings and placement drives.
- IIT BOMBAY Spoken Tutorials (Online), where students can learn various skill-based courses in online mode.
- Our college has a Virtual Classroom for online teaching, through which our teachers give access to students across Telangana, in subjects where there are no teachers available. Ex: Geography, Sociology, Mass Communication and Journalism.
- Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) to improve innovation and creativity among students.
- E-Governance: The college has adopted complete automation in admissions, general administration and Examination Branch etc.
- The college has a Wi-Fi Enabled and eco-friendly campus, where ICT enabled teaching is adopted for better teaching-learning experience.
- In order to strengthen Skill-based education, the college has MOUs and Linkages with many Academic Bodies, Research organizations and Industries like NIN, NGRI, BSI, OU, HCU etc; and also, with Social Service Organizations and NGOs such as Roshni, Asmitha, Lions Club, Rotary Club etc.

PROGRESS/ACHIEVEMENTS:

- The Institution has got renewal of Autonomous status for the second cycle on 8th November 2021, which stands valid till the AY 2024-25.
- The College secured A+ Grade with 3.5 CGPA in the fourth cycle of NAAC, conducted during August 2022, and stands as the top most college in the state of Telangana. The Grade is valid till 29th August 2027.
- With the financial support from Higher Education Department, Government of Telangana and CCE, the institution is constructing additional classrooms and laboratories on the third floor of the old block, with solar panels, which generate 80 KW solar power, to be ready by July 2023.

- With CSR Funding from MEIL (MEGA Engineering and Infrastructure Limited), hundred toilet facility was built for the girl students, which are maintained by the SULABH International Social Services Organization.
- Midday meal scheme in collaboration with Akshaya Patra was introduced for the students from November 2022, through which nearly 400 students are benefitted with nutritious meal. This program was started with donations from faculty, and got strengthened with donation of seven lakhs from Lion. Prasad, Hyderabad.
- And currently, the Midday meal scheme got an additional funding from Dodla Dairy farm under CSR activity, which would help us to continue the Midday meal scheme for the next AY 2023-24. My sincere gratitude to all the donors, who are making an attempt to help the undernourished girls and converting them into empowered, healthy women.

1. **Charity club, Sidhatva International Foundation:** under this club, students conduct various activities related to social responsibility, social service and charity. This club moulds the students into responsible citizens of the country.
 - **School Education Kit distribution programme:** 30th July 2022, Social responsibility team visited ZP High School, Gattu Ippalapalli, Ranga reddy, Telangana .The kit consisting of schoolbag ,note books and other stationery, with a cost of Rs.1000/ each, 200 such kits were distributed to the high school students of ZPHS, Gattu Ippalapally.
 - **RAKHI EVENT @CHARLAPALLI JAIL:** As an act of solidarity, on 11.08.2022, team Sidhatva went to the Agricultural Colony of Prisoners, Charlapally to celebrate Raksha Bandhan with the inmates.
 - **Fistful of Rice 27.12.2022:** the students collected approx. 70 kgs of rice after running a rice collection drive at the college and donated it to Kashi Annapurna Seva Trust, which will feed 500+ patients from Niloufer and NIMS Hospital.
 - **Donation of blankets and sanitary pads:** Collection drive from 8th to 12th December 2022 and then successfully distributed 25 Blankets and 30 packets of Sanitary pads to the ladies of Ashreya Old age Home at Miyapur.
 - Every year arranges Chalivendrum outside the college campus, during summer, which serves the general public.
2. **Each One Teach One Program:** Our students extend a helping hand to the schools that are located in our surroundings. Under Social Responsibility activity, our students go to the adopted schools once or twice in a week, in adjustment with the regular schedule, and teach basic concepts in mathematics, English and Sciences to the school students.

- Department of English - adopted Govt. High School, Begumpet. Our students go to the school and teach the basic grammar and communicative skills for 8th, 9th and 10th class students.
- Department of Mathematics - adopted Govt. High School, Begumpet, and offered teaching extension for 9th & 10th class students, for a period of three months.
- Department of Chemistry – visited Govt. High School, Rasoolpura during December 2022; and donated 100 books and pens to 10th class students. Our students demonstrated chemistry experiments related to oxidation, reduction reactions, titrations etc. to the 9th & 10th class students in the school.

3. **Department of Applied Nutrition** conducted one week awareness program on “Health & Nutrition” to educate school students about healthy life style choices and habits. First Year Applied Nutrition students went to different Government and private schools from 17th to 23rd March, 2023. 11 batches of 5 students each have participated in the program.

4. **Science Exhibition:** All the science departments together conducted a science exhibition 28.02.2023 on the eve of “Science Day 2022”, where working models were prepared and displayed by our students and the exhibition was thrown open for the students in surrounding schools.

5. **Botany Department:** Distribution of Books and other Material to the students of 4 Government schools located around Gattu Ippalapalle in collaboration with staff of AG’s office on 30.07.2022.

6. **Chemical free Daily Use products:** Every year, “Chem Pak” club of Chemistry department conducts workshop on “Preparation & Exhibition of Daily Use Products”, where products such as soaps, shampoo, Vaseline, lip balm, sanitizer, floor cleanser, oils, mehendi, kumkum etc. are prepared by the students and kept for sale to the students and staff of the college. There is a great demand for the products, hence they are prepared and sold on a regular basis through Student Self Help Groups (SSHGs)

7. **Voice4Girls Orientation Program, 06-01-2023:** Internship Recruitment program, where 19 students were selected from the college, and they conducted one-week residential workshop for girl students from government schools and teach them about menstrual health and hygiene.

8. **SHE LEADS Program:** Under this program, our students organize 2KRun, 5KRun to create awareness on AIDS prevention, FIT India, Say NO to Drugs etc. They also participate in Government Pulse Polio programs.
9. **Youth for Social Impact (YFSI):** Under this program, during October 2022, our students conducted an experiment namely “LENO” which means “Lessons, Not Text Books” where they have studied the problem of heavy school bags for school going children and made an attempt to find possible solutions.
10. The students under YFSI, have also attended a 3day Boot camp and training, from 21st to 23rd November 2022, at EPTRI, Gachibowli and T-Hub (Technology Hub for Women Entrepreneurs) the world’s largest incubation innovation centre.
11. **BHAGYA:** Under this, “Kanti Velugu” program was conducted, where not only our students, but also their parents got health checkup. MEDICAL CAMP, Kanti velugu programme, Date:27-02-2023 to 03-03-2023. All the five NSS units of the college, Eye check-up camp was conducted in collaboration with Bhagya health club and spectacles were distributed by collecting Aadhar as Identity.
12. Thyroid and Diabetes Checkup camp was conducted, where all the staff and students got checked up for any relevant health issues.
13. Menstrual hygiene and cervical cancer Awareness 28-10-2022 by Swapnika Reha NGO Cancer Awareness Program was conducted by Dept. of Bio Technology, where eminent doctors spoke to sensitize students regarding occurrence and prevention of cancer.
14. **CPR (Cardiac Pulmonary Resuscitation) TRAINING PROGRAMME:** Team of Doctors from Gandhi Medical College have conducted a training program on CPR, on 09.03.2023. Organized by Dept. of Business Management, students and staff took part in this training, and learnt the basic techniques of CPR.

Autonomy Funds Utilization:

- The Institution gets funding of fifteen lakhs under UGC/Autonomy scheme, which is utilized to strengthen the qualitative aspects of education in the college, where the funds are allocated for Curricular and extra-curricular activities such as extension lectures, field trips, student workshops, augmentation of infrastructure etc.
- **FDP on “Soft Skills & ICT Tools for Teachers”:** With funding from Autonomy, the Department of English & UGC has conducted a two-day

FDP for the faculty of GDCWB on “Soft Skills & ICT Tools for Teachers” on 11th & 12th January 2023.

- Various departments conducted thirty-six Extension Lectures for this AY, in which eminent professors from other universities have given lectures, which helps in academic enrichment.
