


AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS BY NIPAM


Objectives:

The Copy rights are concerned not only with books, but songs, audio, films, music and drama etc. the Trade marks are concerned with the protection of better protection of trade marks for goods and services and also to prevent fraudulent use of the mark. Service mark is a brand name or logo that identifies the provider of a service. The Indian patent office processes the

patent under the following categories: Utility, Design, Provisional and plant patents. Patent applications satisfies the three criteria: Novelty, Inventive step and Industrial applicability.
