

About YUVATHARANGAM

There are 100 Government Degree Colleges under the administrative control of the Department of Collegiate Education offering General Education in the form of B.A., B.Com. and B. Sc. courses. Around 1 lakh students are pursuing UG & PG courses in these Colleges.

As real education aims at all-round development of students, the department has initiated various curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities with the objective to facilitate students pursuing general education to explore their innate talents and emerge as leaders in the field of their choice. As a part of these initiatives, a festival of excellence called “**Yuvatharangam**” is being celebrated every year.

The festival encompasses all stakeholders, students, teachers, principals, non-teaching staff, academic administrators at the institution and department levels. The services rendered by all the staff are acknowledged and appreciated the best are rewarded and it is a platform for students to showcase their talent in cultural, literary, sports and games and excellence in academics. Thus, this festival has evolved into a platform for celebration of excellence.

“Yuvatharangam” is celebrated in three Categories:

- 1. Academic**
- 2. Cultural and Literary**
- 3. Games and Sports**

1. ACADEMIC

The objective of Academic Festival is to identify the best performing Principals, Teachers, Non-Teaching Staff, students and colleges and to recognize and motivate them by giving appreciation awards/certificates.

Awards for Students

1. Best outgoing Students: Prizes are awarded to students for securing highest marks in the Annual Examinations in April, 2015 in 21 subjects. In respect of Commerce subject 3 Prizes i.e. 1st, 2nd & 3rd are awarded.

For Staff working in Colleges:

a. Awards for Principals are selected and awarded for their administrative abilities, leadership qualities, sincerity, hard work and commitment. They are evaluated based on their AADPI (Academic Administrative & Development Performance Indicator) score during the last three years.

b. Awards for Teachers : Teachers who made an impact on the quality of education and who are instrumental in implementation of activities initiated by the department are rewarded with recognition of their services. Teachers are selected based on their API (Academic Performance Indicator) score of three previous years in the 21 subjects.

c. Awards for Non-Teaching Staff: Prizes are also awarded to Non-Teaching Staff working in Colleges, RJDCE, Warangal and at O/o CCE to acknowledge their services and to encourage their service to the institution in the following categories.

Our Village - Our Pond





All remind me of our village!



Our place, close to my heart and soothing
