#### MEGA HEALTH CAMP - MEDICOVER HOSPITALS Dt.17-11-2022 & 18-11-2022

Medical camps provide free medical advice, medicine and refer for specialised treatment or surgery whenever it is required. These camps make sure people are getting the health care at the right time and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns into serious.

Keeping in view of students and staff welfare the Health Bhaya –Government Degree College for Women, Begumpet taken up a prestigious mega health camp in our college premises . In collaboration with the MEDICOVER Hospital, Begumpet organised the camp. In this all the students, Teaching, Nonteaching staff along with the student parents also participated.

This program held for **Two days** where they tested Blood Pressure, Sugar levels, Height, Weight, ECG supported by the Doctors and Pathological department staff. The coordinator officer Mr.Chanti has taken a special care. Dr.P.S.Rajani, Health Bhagya coordinator and the members Ms.V.Rohini along with the Health Bhagya students union members were also participated actively for smooth functioning of the program.

During the program the Director for Medicover hospital visited the college. With advice of college principal, Dr.K. Padmavathi madam also arranged counselling for students where students shared their emotional and health issues with the counseller doctor and stabilised by themselves.

Later we also organised gynaecologist Dr.Swapna, checked many students and came to know that many students are facing PCOD problem. Doctor also adviced few tips in lifestyle to get rid of this probem.

Keeping in view of the students problem especially girls PCOD problem Health Bhagya in coordination with Dept.of Zoology organised an extension lecture on PCOD by Dr.Shilpa ,so that students will comprehend the issue about how this PCOD became more prominent even in very young students and found the remedies given by the doctor.

#### **Objective of the program:**

- 1.To provide free medical aid for all the students ,teaching and non teaching staff.
- 2. Early diagnosis is possible with the health camps
- 3. Needy students may get specialised and free treatment.

#### **Outcome of the program:**

- 1. Most of the students are diagnosed with PCOD problems and were taken medication with the advice of doctors
- 2. One of the girl suffering from cardiac related problem and is taking proper treatment.

- 3. Some of our staff members were diagnosed with benign tumours.
- 4. Most of our teaching and non-teaching staff had altered Blood Pressures and Sugar levels and were got alerted.
