

BOS Meetings were held by all the Departments in the college and the syllabus of all the concerned subjects was thoroughly upgraded. Academic regulations and curriculum for the Academic Year is reviewed. Panel of Examiners were prepared and method of evaluation including pattern of question paper was also discussed. Evaluation of students is comprehensive and includes Internal Assessments, Seminars, Assignments and End Semester Exams. Allocation of credits for each course is discussed thoroughly. The details of BOS meetings were placed before the Academic council as at Annexure-II.

The scheme of examination which has been changed from the academic year 2019-20, approved in the 7th Academic council is being followed for 1st & 2nd Years, i.e. 60 marks for external examination and 40 marks for internals. For final year students old scheme of examination is followed i.e. 75 marks for external and 25 marks for internals examination.

Division of 40 marks is as follows.

1. 20 marks international assessment in the form of descriptive exam, where two internals will be conducted and average of two is considered.

2. Unit wise test in the form of 20 objective questions, carrying half mark each and a total weightage of 10 marks.

3. 5 marks for seminar / quiz/ group discussion and 5 marks for assignments.

The semester end examinations for the courses commencing from 2019-20 are evaluated for 60 marks. The question paper shall be set as approved in BOS meeting and the same is to be given to the controller of examinations.

A candidate shall be declared to have passed in individual Theory course if she secures a minimum of 40% aggregate marks (Internal & semester end examination marks put together), subject to a minimum of 40% marks in semester end examination.

The syllabus is as per CBCS pattern, unitization, pattern of question papers, panel of examiners, internal assessment, and semester end examinations.
