



Semester VI: includes Paper VI-Core, Elective-I and Elective-II including both Theory and Practicals as follows:



- The syllabus for each paper is divided into Four Units, Units: I, II, III & IV.
- It is resolved to conduct TWO internal assessments for 25 Marks (Written test 15 M, seminar 4 M, Assignment 4 M, Attendance 2 M) during each semester and have average of two to be considered as Internal marks for semester results.
- Maximum marks for end semesters' examination is 75 Marks and the pattern is:  
**Section-A:** Four questions. Long Answer type. One compulsory from each Unit.  $4 \times 10 = 40$  M.  
**Section-B:** Five questions Short answer type with internal choice  $5 \times 5 = 25$  M.  
**Section-C:** Five questions Very Short answer type with internal choice  $5 \times 2 = 10$  M.
- It is resolved to conduct practical examination at the end of each semester (Semester V & VI) for a maximum of 50 Marks each.
