#### Board of studies meeting for year 2016-17:

The Board of Studies Meeting of Department of Sanskrit for the year 2016-17 is held on 26-3-16 at University College of Arts and Social Sciences, O.U., in the department of Sanskrit at 1.00 A.M.

The following resolutions have been taken in the meeting.

1. It is resolved to continue Sanskrit, second language as 3 Credit course per Semester following UGC guidelines for allocation of Credits as per the teaching hours per week.
2. It is resolved to continue the syllabus of Sanskrit i.e. the text "DaiviVak-1" prescribed by Osmania University for B.A., B.Sc, B.com.I year. Adopting CBCS system of Grading as per the rules of CCE, being implemented from the year 2014. It is adopted for I , II, III & IV semesters.
3. It is resolved that BOS committee will convene meeting if any changes are there in the syllabus in I and II Semesters of Second Language Sanskrit for the year 2016-17.
4. It was resolved to continue the contents of the text book i.e. 3 lessons and grammar from Daivi-vak – 1 for Semester –I (Sharanagatihi + Matrudeshasya oujjwalyam + mitrasampraptihih + Shabdarupani + Sandhi's) and 4 lessons and grammar (Raghoh oudaryam + Ahimsa paramo dharmah + Chikrodakatha + Dhaturupani + Samasas) for II Semester as prescribed.
5. It is resolved to continue practical in Second language Sanskrit for 50 marks in I and II semester. It is resolved to introduce practical in Second language Sanskrit for 50 marks in III and IV semester. **Baladarshah** is the text Prescribed for I, II, III and IV Semester

  
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Practical to test Reading, Writing skills of the students. And for recitation selected verses (niti slokas) were prescribed.

6. It is resolved to continue the syllabus of Sanskrit i.e. the text "DaiviVak-2" prescribed by Osmania University for B.A., B.Sc, B.com.II year without making any changes in the syllabus for the year 2016-17. Adopting CBCS system of Grading as per the rules of CCE, being implemented from the year 2014. It is adopted for III & IV semesters.

7. It is resolved to continue the contents of the text book i.e. 3 lessons and grammar from Daivi-Vak-2 for III Semester ( **Pratimanatakam, Shukanasopadeshah and Dakara katha, Kavayah Shastrakaravibhagah, Grammer – Shabdarupani**).

3 lessons and grammar from DaiviVak-2 (**Susamhatabharatam+ Shikshyanushasanam + Bhojasya saraswati sushama + Grammar – Alankarah + Krudantarupani**) prescribed for IV Semester.

8. The pattern of evaluation and examination was discussed and resolved to conduct two internals in each semester and to take the average of the two for computation in marks memo. It is resolved to set the question paper of the main exam for 75 marks and the internal Exam for 25marks.

Three home assignments will be given. Best two will be awarded.


Two Assignments - 2 x 10 = 20
