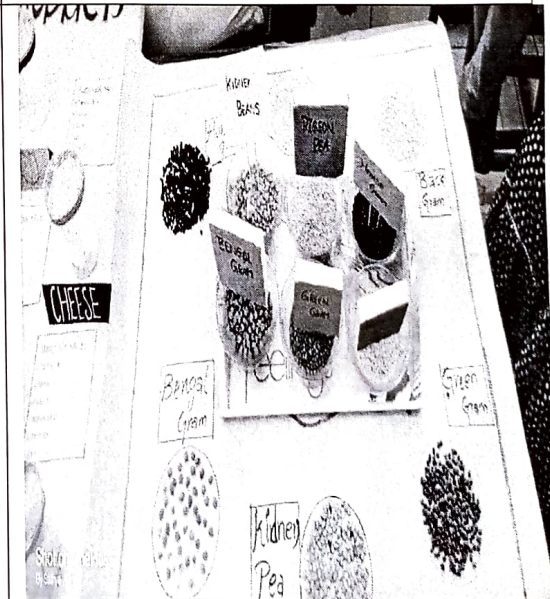
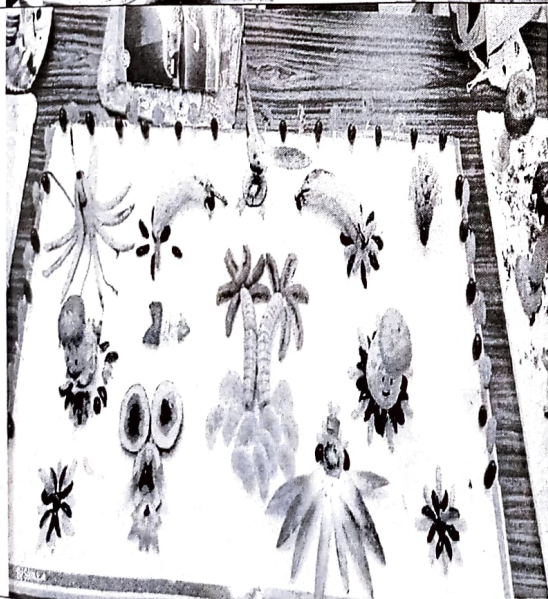
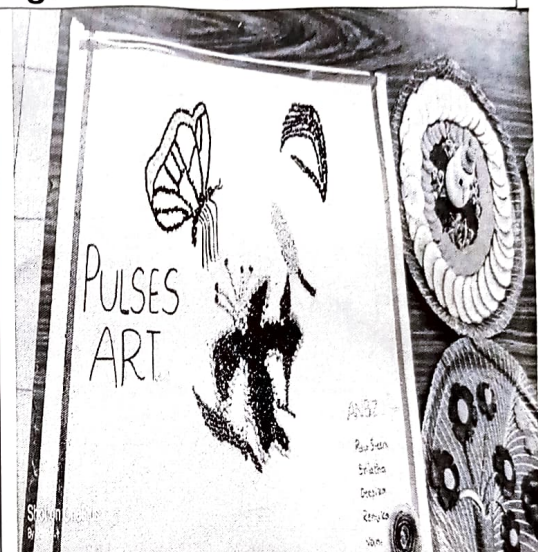
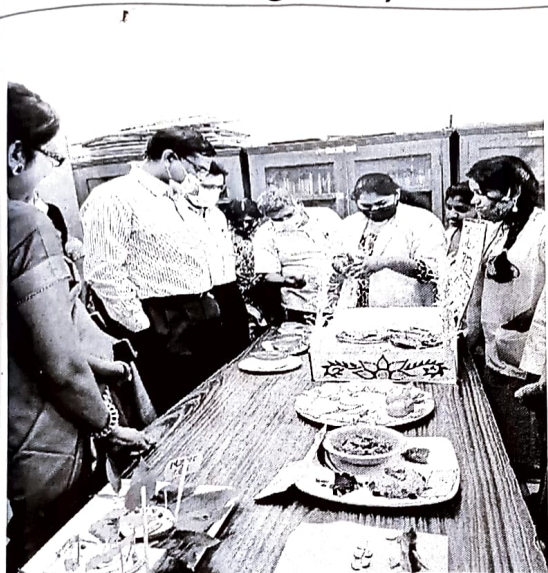
On the occasion of Science day celebrations a two day Programme was conducted by Dept of Botany and other Life sciences on 26.02.2021 and 27.02.2021.
