

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OYSTER AND GOVT.DEGREE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, BEGUMPET



I. Parties to the MOA.

This Memorandum of Association is designed to reflect the understandings between the Organization by Youth for Social Transformation and Environmental Recorp (a registered non-profit organization Reg. No.442/09) here in after O.Y.S.T.E.R. — Party 1 and GOVT.DEGREE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, BEGUMPET herein after GOVT.DEGREE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, BEGUMPET... Party 2.

Duration of Agreement

This Memorandum of Association is made on 6 September, 2019 by and between 10 AM to 4PM. It shall remain in effect (continue) until Five consecutive academic years or until terminated by either Party with 30-day written notice.

III. Performance Requirements and Goals

The following common objectives should be included in each copy of the MOA between O.Y.S.T.E.R. and GOVT.DEGREE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, BEGUMPET, with respect to the subject matter agreed upon for this MOA only:

Party 1 in collaboration with Party 2 will stan a three months Certhicare Course in Youth Community Orientation with both theoretical and field work components.

IV. Referral Arrangements

In compliance with the mutually accepted understanding it is hereby declared that the parties to the MOA will in furtherance to the various clauses of this MOA w.e.f. 04th September, 2019 to achieve the common goals would consider the engagement and establishment of any other contracts, deeds, circulars, notices and any other such mutually consented documents between each other and between third parties, either singly or in co-ordination; with the due knowledge about such engagements and establishments to both parties by each other, duly drafted and attested by both the parties.

will be extended further on the interest of the mutually consenting parties to this MOA.

V. Information sharing and infrastructural support

The material of the intellect, essential for the commencement of the course as mentioned in clause III would be the combined effort of both the parties.

Parties 2 being the educational institution, it is agreed there to be a source of library assistance if any required². Party 1 would share & distribute³ the research, survey & publication material related to this course to the library of Party 2. The certificates will be given to the students after successful completion. The certificates will be awarded collectively by Party 1 & Party 2 the Party 2 shall provide the required infrastructure in terms of projector, classroom / hall to hold any meeting and awareness programme. This provision will be made without any disturbance to the activities of Party 2. During the socially relevant awareness programmes and rallies Party 2 shall allow the participation of the students and motivate them to actively involve themselves towards community development

VI. Cost allocation and resource sharing

The course, intended would be a cost efficient initiative with no fee collected from the students joining in for paying of any salaries, stipend and other allowance to the volunteers, staff, guest lecturers and other faculty involved in the imparting of the course curriculum. It is desirable to have basic stationary support from Party 2. But if required minimal registration fee will be collected from students.

³ Subject to the discretion of Part 1 and exclusion of all non-related officials & personal documents of Party 1.

VII. Dispute resolution

The Party hereto shall first attempt to resolve all disputes arising from the provisions contained in this MOA, informally and at the lowest applicable staff level. If dispute resolution is not accomplished, any arty may call on the parties to formally discuss and resolve all such disputes. The parties shall mediate the dispute and shall have final authority to resolve the issue. Should the parties fail to resolve the dispute, the dispute snall be referred to the arbitral proceedings only, with individual arbitrators in any number to be referred to by each Party on their behalf.

VIII. Severability

If any part of this MOA is found to be null and void, or is otherwise stricken, the rest of this MOA shall remain in full force and effect, until renegotiated or rewritten.

IX. Modification / termination

This MOA constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties hereto. This MOA may be modified, altered, revised, extended or renewed by mutual return consent of both/cm parties, by the issuance of return amendment, signed and dated by both parties. Submission of a revised MOA does not necessarily require a modification to the local plan. Any party of this MOA may terminate their participation in this MOA by giving not less than ninety (90) calendar day's prior return notice of intent to terminate their participation with regard to the subject matter of this MOA.

X. Confidentiality

The parties to this MOA shall pledge that appropriate confidentiality parameters will be honoured and that separate confidentiality agreements among partners wishing access to other partner's information may need to be executed if required or as per the will of the Parties. Any infringement or non—compliance with confidentiality by either of the parties with respect to the whole body of the MOA would initiate arbitrary proceeding with a written notice of the thirty days to the infringing Parties.
