INTRODUCTION

Government Degree College for Women (Autonomous), Begumpet, Hyderabad established in 1971, caters to the students hailing from the semi urban and rural areas of throughout the Country. The college provides university education to deserving candidates in a secular atmosphere and it is the most sought-after institution in the twin-cities. With an objective of “**Empowerment of Women through Knowledge**”, the college helps the students to become truly empowered citizens. The college has completed 49 years and making a remarkable contribution in the field of education will be celebrating its Golden Jubilee in the next academic year.

During the last five decades the college has grown from strength to strength and presently enables about 4500 students to access higher education. This year, the college has registered student strength of 3676. Keeping in pace with the changing needs of the society, the college has introduced new 19 combinations taking the total number of courses to 52 during this academic year.

AUTONOMY

Recognizing the potential of the college the UGC has conferred autonomous status to the college in the year 2012. As such the first year students admitted into UG programme will conform to the autonomous pattern of education. The teaching and evaluation are conducted in six semesters. The college follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The college has applied for Extension of Autonomous status in its second cycle; as a part of this process, the Autonomy Expert Committee has visited the college during September 2021, and the Autonomy status has been extended till 2025-26.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college is ready with the new block that has three floors with spacious class rooms and laboratories. The old block has a good Library with a Reference section and a Reading Room, Spacious Playground and Open Air Auditorium. The Computer Center, TSKC Lab, English Language Lab (ELL), the Health centre, the Gymnasium, the MANA TV (T-SAT Nipuna) and the Audio-Visual Department are the other supporting services provided by the college. The infrastructure in the college is conducive to the multifaceted courses that we offer. Our Library comprises 22,000 books, a Reading Room with e-corner, several Journals related to various subjects, Magazines and Newspapers. In the light of such academic and infrastructural facilities, we reiterate our commitment to our objective '**Learning is the Best Ornament**', as we firmly believe that women empowerment alone can take the society to greater heights.

NAAC ACCREDITATION

The College is gearing up for the 4th cycle of NAAC Accreditation. During the academic year 2016-2017, the college was assessed and re-accredited by NAAC with B+ grade securing CGPA 2.64 for 3rd Cycle.

IQAC

The Internal quality and Assessment Cell plays a crucial role in educational institutions. The cell ensures planning, guiding and monitoring Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Enhancement (QE) activities of the colleges. The IQAC is the driving force and can be said as an umbrella of an institution that is engaged in coordinating, suggesting activities towards academic excellence. The Cell ushers in quality by chalking out strategies to enhance quality of education and achieve the institution's objectives and goals.

TSKC

The Telangana Skill Knowledge Centre (TSKC) in the college is a prestigious initiative of the State Government and our college has been identified as the nodal centre for TSKC activities. At the TSKC, students are given training in Computer Skills, Aptitude and Communication Skills to instil confidence in the students to face the selection process for various companies. The TSKC interacts with various industries to conduct placement drives on campus and recruit students. This year 158 final year students were trained in Python Online Course in collaboration with Microsoft and Hope Foundation.

RESULTS

The pass percentage of the college increased to 95% in the Academic Year 2020-2021.

GDCW TEAM

There are about fifty experienced teaching Staff, a Librarian, a Physical Director and Computer Instructors. Most of our lecturers received Best teacher Awards from the Government of Andhra Pradesh and other organizations. The Administrative Officer
