

Report on the Workshop on Effective Use of ICT Tools in Teaching and Learning conducted by IQAC

The IQAC organized a One Day Faculty Development Programme on the "Effective Use of ICT Tools in Teaching and Learning" for the entire teaching faculty on 2 November, 2021 at the Seminar Hall of the College. The Principal of the College, Dr K.Padmavathi inaugurated the program along with Dr T.Annie Sheron, the IQAC Coordinator. The programme was divided into two segments:

In the forenoon session, there was a presentation on the topic Use of Virtual Labs by Dr. N. Harikrishna, Assistant Professor of Microbiology, GDC, Gajwel.

The Resource person provided insights on the importance of Virtual Labs which is an initiative of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, under the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology. The virtual labs aim to cater and provide remote access to Laboratories in various disciplines of Science to students of allied subjects to all levels from UG level to Research.

Virtual Labs do not require any additional infrastructural setup for conducting experiments at user premises. Students can learn the different simulations by themselves with help of instruction provided in the experiment modules.

Virtual Labs provide the following:

- 1. Access to quality simulation-based labs for science students who lack these lab facilities in their institution or who are taking classes virtually.
- 2. A complete Learning Management System which enables students to learn and assimilate.
- 3. Teacher-training and skill-set augmentation through workshops and on-site training.
- 4. Students are assessed after the simulation of experiment is completed with questionnaires.

The session concluded with the Q&A followed by the Vote of Thanks.

The post lunch session was in the online mode on the topic the Use of ICT Tools in Teaching and Learning by Prof. T.Mrunalini, Director, EMRC, Osmania University, Hyderabad. The presentation highlighted on the existing framework of Teacher Digital Capability Development. The presentation covered aspects like Teacher Commitment, SWOT Analysis of the learner and the teacher, Teaching Competencies, Personal Developmental Plan, Innovation and Media skills etc.

The presenter gave indepth information on Innovative Pedagogies like cross over teaching, teaching through smart boards, flipped classrooms, collaborative teaching, teaching through 3D printing technology, cloud computing and so on. The presenter shared many online teaching tools to the faculty at the end of the session. The FDP concluded with Vote of Thanks.
