REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

The Department of Political Science, Government Degree College for Women, Begumpet, Hyderabad has organized an International conference on "New Dimensions in Higher Education in the Post Covid-19: Global Perspective" on 24th & 25th March 2022 at ICSSR-SRC, Hall, Osmania University, Hyderabad sponsored by ICSSR, New Delhi, TSCHE & NAAC. The Conference has begun with the welcome address by Dr.K.Kamala, Convener of the Conference stated that the conference has received 158 abstracts of which four speakers from USA, Singapore, Hong Kong & China have participated and also received papers from more than 15 states of India. The conference was inaugurated by Dr. K. Padmavathi Principal, Government Degree College for Women, Begumpet. The Chief Guest of the conference Shri.
