### Feedback Analysis on Curriculum Design & Review of Syllabus for the Academic year 2022-2023

Feedback has been collected manually and electronically (through Google Form) from the Teachers, Employers, Parents and Students on curriculum of Courses and related aspects in the month of March - 2023 to make teaching learning process more effective and to meet the needs of the students in all aspects. Feedback forms have been designed separately for Teachers, Employers, Parents and Students. Feedback forms were analysed by IQAC Committee. 42 Students, 03 Employers, 14 Faculty, 13 Alumni and 10 Parents were recorded and analysed on curriculum, academic environment and other student related services on campus.

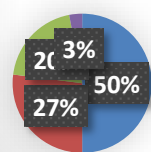
### Analysis of the Feedback

#### Student Feedback

Student feedback forms 60 were issued to the students of all sections randomly in March - 2023 and 42 forms were collected after a week. The data in these forms is tabulated as shown below. Out of 42 student respondents above 50% were Excellent, 27.3% were very good, 20.5% were average, 3% poor with the curriculum of the courses offered in the college and rated above 95% excellent, very good and Average.

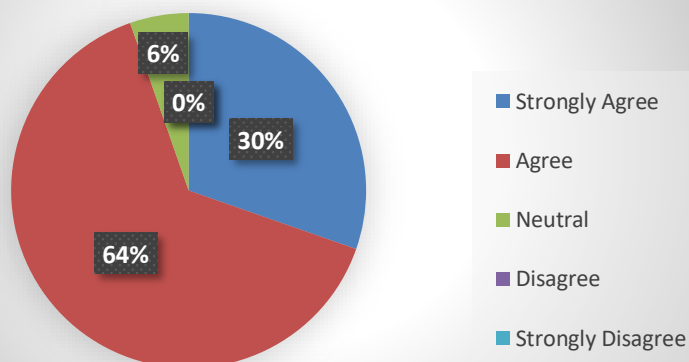


### Teacher Feedback

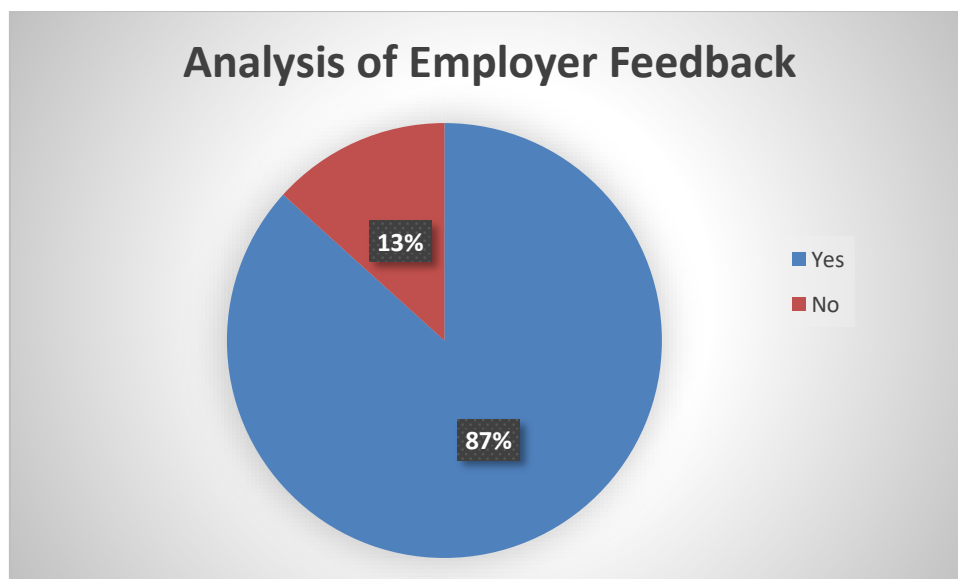

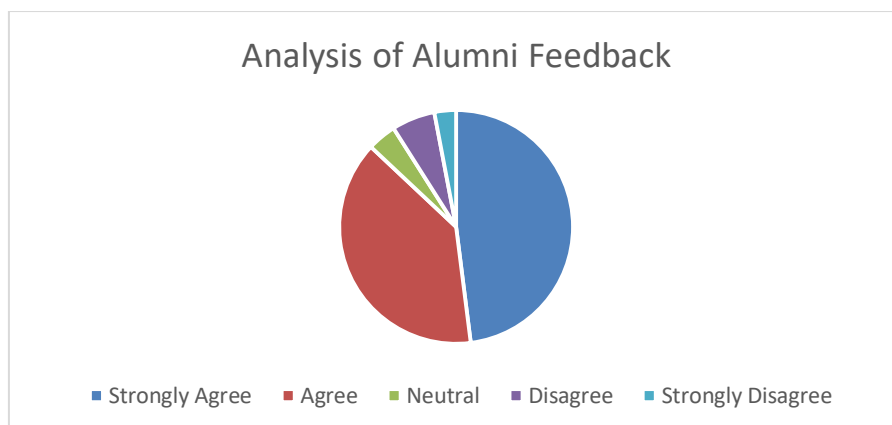

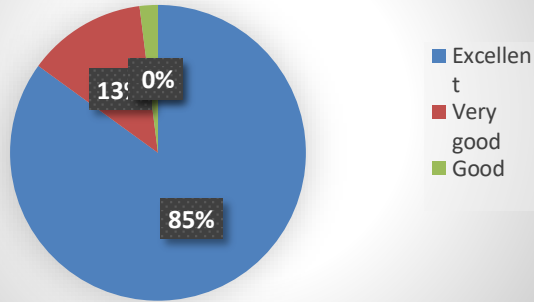


## Parents Feedback
