






FREE DISTRIBUTION OF MEDICINES

She was a prominent politician and first female Prime Minister of India. In her tenure she nationalized the banks, implemented the Twenty Point Programme and control the terrorism. Garibi Hatao Desh Bachao ("Remove poverty, rescue the country") was the theme and slogan of Indira Gandhi's 1971 election campaign. She was assassinated by her body guards on 31 October 1984 at her residence in Safdarjung Road, New Delhi.
