Annual report of the celebrations and commemorative events for the academic year 2021 - 2022

National Festivals

Independence Day: Independence Day is significant as it commemorates the valour and spirit of the freedom fighters who fought for the independence of the nation from British rule. The day is recognized as that of national pride and honor, with the Principal hoisting the flag and addressing the students about the importance of the day.

Republic Day: Republic Day is celebrated on 26th January every year to mark the day on which our constitution came into effect in 1950. After this day our country truly became democratic and independent.

State Festivals

Telangana Formation Day: The formation of Telangana signifies the victory of a sustained movement that saw the large Andhra Pradesh state bifurcation into two entities. A 57-year-old fight for the separate state finally bore fruit, bringing hope to the people of Telangana for a better future complete with a distinct identity.

Bhathukamma: Bhathukamma is a colorful and vibrant festival of Telangana and celebrated by women, with flowers that grow exclusively in each region. This festival is a symbol of Telangana's cultural identity. It is a celebration that honors the Goddess Parvati for blessing the year's crop harvest and fortune she has brought in the year. Bhathukamma's main festivities include the creation of flower stacks by the women of Telangana, which are then arranged into the shape of a temple's gopura as a symbol of their gratitude.

Samakka Jatara: Is a festival to honour the Hindu Tribal goddesses, celebrated in the state of Telangana, India. This Jatara is known for witnessing one of the largest people gatherings in the world. People offer Bangaram (jiggery). The jatara begins in Medaram in Taddei Mandala in

Mulugu district. The rituals related to the goddesses are entirely conducted by the Koya tribe priests, in accordance with Koya customs and traditions.

Events to promote national consciousness

Teachers' Day (Dr. Radhakrishnan's birthday): In India, it is marked on the birthday of Dr Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan who was the first Vice President of India (1952–1962) and also a highly-respected teacher, philosopher and prolific statesman. Dr Radhakrishnan went on to become the second President of India (1962-1967) and was of the opinion that “teachers should be the best minds in the country.”

Mahatma Gandhi birthday, International day of non-violence: The International Day of Non-Violence is observed on **2 October**, the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi, leader of the Indian independence movement and pioneer of the philosophy and strategy of non-violence.

Rastriya Ekta Diwas (in memory of Sardar Patel): As per a statement by the Home Ministry, the day provides "an opportunity to re-affirm the inherent strength and resilience of our nation to withstand the actual and potential threats to the unity, integrity, and security of our country”.

Days that promote scientific temperament

National Science Day: National Science Day is celebrated to commemorate the discovery of Raman Effect by Nobel laureate, physicist CV Raman on this day in 1928.

World Blood Donor Day: The day was created to raise global awareness of the need for blood products for transfusion, highlighting the critical contribution voluntary, unpaid blood donors make to national health systems and supporting national blood transfusion services in expanding their voluntary blood donor programmes.

National Sports Day: It is observed on 29 August every year to commemorate the birthday of Indian hockey legend Major Dhyan Chand. Born on 29 August 1905 in present-day Prayagraj, UP, Major Dhyan Chand was the captain of the Gold medal-winning Indian hockey team at the Berlin Olympics in 1936.

NSS Day: Every year on September 24, India celebrates National Service Scheme Day (NSS Day). NSS Day is an occasion to praise selfless deeds of its participants for the betterment of the society.

Mathematics Day: It is celebrated on 22 December annually to mark the birth anniversary of legendary Indian mathematician, Srinivasa Ramanujan and his contributions to the field of mathematics.

Hindi Divas: Hindi Divas or National Hindi Day is celebrated every year on September 14 to mark the adaptation of Hindi (written in Devanagari script) as the official language and national language by the Constituent Assembly on September 14, 1949. Hindi Divas is celebrated across the country on 14 September to spread awareness and the importance of the Hindi language.

Telugu Bhasha Dinostavam: Telugu Language Day is observed on 29 August each year in the State of Andhra Pradesh of the Republic of India. This date was chosen to coincide with the birthday of the Telugu poet Gidugu Venkata Ramamurthy.

Telangana Bhasha Dinostavanm: To commemorate the birthday of Poet Kaloji, our Telangana State has declared September 9th as 'Telugu Bhasha Dinotsavam'.

Days that promote environmental consciousness

World ozone day: World Ozone Day is observed on September 16 every year to spread awareness among people about the depletion of Ozone Layer and find possible solutions to preserve it.

Harithaharam: The program was launched by Telangana Chief Minister Kalvakuntla Chandrashekar Rao on 3 July 2015. It is one of the Telangana Flagship programmes to rejuvenate degraded forests, protecting these forests from threats such as smuggling, encroachment, fire and grazing.

National Energy Conservation Day (DEC14): The National Energy Conservation Day is being celebrated every year on December 14 since 1991. The Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), under Ministry of Power spearheads the celebrations every year. The objective to celebrate the National Energy Conservation Day is to drive mass awareness about the importance of energy efficiency and conservation.

World Environment day: is celebrated annually on 5 June and is the United Nations' principal vehicle for encouraging awareness and action for the protection of the environment. It has been a platform for raising awareness on environmental issues as marine pollution, over population, global warming, sustainable development and wildlife crime.

Events that promote health and well being

International Yoga Day: The International Day of Yoga aims to raise awareness worldwide of the many benefits of practicing yoga. The essence of yoga is balance - not just balance within the body or that between the mind and the body, but also balance in the human relationship with the world. Yoga emphasizes the values of mindfulness, moderation, discipline and perseverance. When applied to communities and societies, Yoga offers a path for sustainable living.

World Health Day: It is celebrated annually and each year draws attention to a specific health topic of concern to people all over the world. The date of 7 April marks the anniversary of the founding of WHO in 1948.

Special Days that inculcate rights, duties and responsibilities

Human Right Day: Human Rights Day is observed by the international community every year on 10 December. It commemorates the day in 1948 the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

National Voters Day: National Voters Day is celebrated on 25 January to encourage the youth to participate in the vote in the electoral process. It not only encourages the youth to participate in the electoral process but also focuses on the fact that the right to vote is a basic right.

Constitution Day: On November 26, 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India formally adopted the Constitution of India. It came into force on January 26, 1950. Constitution Day aims to bring awareness about the importance of the Constitution and Dr B R Ambedkar.

World Consumer Rights Day: Every year on March 15, World Consumer Rights Day is commemorated to safeguard consumer rights and to ensure that customers are not subjected to market exploitation or social injustice that may jeopardize their rights.

World Book and Copyright Day: World Book and Copyright Day is a celebration to promote the enjoyment of books and reading. Each year, on 23 April, celebrations take place all over the world to recognize the scope of books - a link between the past and the future, a bridge between generations and across cultures.

World Intellectual Property Day: The day is celebrated to make people know how intellectual property (IP) rights encourage innovation and creativity.

International Women's Day: International Women's Day (March 8) is a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural, and political achievements of women.

Girl child Day: On December 19, 2011, United Nations General Assembly adopted Resolution 66/170 to declare October 11 as the International Day of the Girl Child, to recognize girls' rights and the unique challenges girls face around the world.
