Government Degree College , located at Bhupalpally, Jayashankar Bhupalpally District of Telangana state, was established in the year of 2008 and the college is affiliated to Kakatiya University Warangal. It got recognized under section 2 (f) on 08-06-2015. Bhupalpally is the New District Head Quarter of JAYASHANKAR BHUPALPALLY Dist in Telangana State. It is popularly known as City of Black Gold, consisting of rich resources of coal mines and industries like Singareni colleries, Power generating project (KTPP). This district is having piligrim centres and historical places like Ramappa, Kaleshwaram and Medaram.

Ramappa temple also known as Rudreshwara temple is a Hindu temple built by Kakatiyas in 13 th century and dedicated to the God Shiva, located --- km from Bhupalpally . On June 25th 2021 the United Educational Scientific and cultural Organization (UNESCO) declared the Ramappa temple as a world Heritage site.

Kaleswaram is a small town in Mahadevpur mandal, in Jayashankar Bhupalpally Distrrict. Kaleswaram is known as Dakshan Kasi, famous for the ancient temple Kaleswara Mukteshwara temple, located in the place where 3 rivers (Godavari from Telangana, Pranahita from Maharashtra and Saraswathi under both these rivers) confluence together with two lingams holding on a single pedestal. Another important feature of Kaleswaram is holding World"s

largest multi stage lift irrigation project on river Godavari to transform Telangana into an agricultural powerhouse. The project will enable farmers to reap multiple crops with year round supply of water.

The Singareni Collieries Company Limited identified coal bearing lands in and around Bhupalpally. The company produces considerable amount of coal from the mines. Keeping in view of the coalmine area, APGENCO has set up a 500 MW (and another unit of 1x600 MW is under construction, thus the total capacity will become 1100 MW) super thermal power plant in Chelpur/Bhupalpally area

Medaram is a village famous for the biggest Tribal festival in Asia Sammakka and Saralamma Jatara, attended by 2 crore people on an average once in two years to honour the Goddesses Sammakka and Saralamma.

The students of Bhupalpally area are socially deprived and unable to go to cities to pursue higher education courses such as B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. Consequently, the Government of Andrapradesh started new Govt. Degree College in Bhupalpally in the Academic year 2008-09. This college is serving the needs of rural students in Bhupalpally and nearby tribal areas.

The college offers five undergraduate programmes B.A. (HEP/Cs E,M), B.A. (HEP/Cs T.M), B.Com. (Computer science) and B.Sc. (MPC/MPCs) & B.Sc.(BZC/BZCs). There are around 500 students pursuing their under graduation in this college. The college offers five undergraduate programms under CBCS, with different combinations for the benefit of the students.

The institution follows the curriculum designed by the Kakatiya university to which the college is affiliated.

Bridge courses are conducted for the needy students at the beginning of the academic year.

Remedial coaching is offered for slow learners and advanced learners are encouraged with study projects.

The In-charges of all departments were conduct review meetings regularly under the supervision of IQAC for sustenance of quality. Seminars, projects, guest lectures, field trips are organized by each department.

Teaching modules and lesson plans are prepared well in advance for effective presentation through innovative teaching methods.
