### Memorandum of Agreement

This Memorandum of Agreement is made between

# Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS)

and

# Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay (ST- IIT Bombay)

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS) is created to promote quality education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It also strengthens the women education at undergraduate level and works towards educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society.

The Spoken Tutorial project developed by IIT Bombay for MHRD, Government of India is the initiative of the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (ICT), launched by the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India. The use of spoken tutorial is to advocate and popularize numerous Open Source software and their utilization.

Spoken tutorial project intends to provide opportunity to conduct software training from ST-IIT Bombay to all the Government Colleges in Telangana state. As the programme is funded by the National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD, Government of India it charges a nominal annual User Fee of Rs.25000/year/college. Spoken Tutorial agreed to charge Rs. 12,50,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh fifty thousand) only to offer training to faculty and students of all the 50 Government Degree Colleges situated in Telangana, for the year 2020-2021. However, among 123 Government Degree Colleges those who are interested to conduct Spoken Tutorial, IT training program can make the subscription fee of Rs. 25,000/- for 1 year and write a letter to CCE office and IIT Bombay, Training Manager to start training in their respective colleges. The program will provide the following benefits to the students and Faculties of GDCs under purview of CCETS-

Students and Teachers receive hands on training through a particular FOSS (Free and Open Source Software) like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHP & MySQL, Java, C/C++, Libre Office etc. The students

who complete the required training hours will be awarded Certificates by Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay.

 The training enhances IT, Software skills and employability for the students and any number of students and faculty can take any number of courses and Certificates in a year with User Fee of Rs. 25000/year/college.

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS) State and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay does hereby agree to the following broad terms of cooperation as under:

## Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS) shall-

- ➤ Will actively work with identified Chief Central Co-ordinator Mr. Balabhaskar from the department who will actively work and co-ordinate with Spoken Tutorial team, IIT Bombay to roll-out and introduce the project into all degree colleges in the state.
- ➤ Put up the signed agreement note on the CCETS website along with Spoken Tutorial site link and Telangana training manager Ms. Preeti Naidu contact details.
- > CCETS to make the Payment through NEFT, introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in colleges.
- > Conduct a Master training program for a faculty member in each Govt. College through Faculty Development Training Program for running Software training SELF learning way in their respective Colleges as one of the initiatives under capacity building.
- > Offer General IT Skills package in Telugu, Tamil, English, Hindi also.
- > Issue circular to all the Govt Colleges to introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training.
- ➤ Have a monitoring system on department's website to track the progress made by the different colleges, suggest bi-monthly reports from colleges to and ST, IIT Bombay.

### The Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay shall-

- > Work as a mentor for the Govt colleges in the Telangana State.
- > Support the training and execution by CCETS by providing manuals and continuous guidance at the unit level that is the Government College.
- Nominate a Representative who will work with the Faculty Development Training Program in CCETS.
- Provide guidance and learning path for progressively higher levels of learning through advanced courses.

- Provide the knowhow and course content material that includes CDs/DVDs, online material, instruction sheets and any other training material related to the Govt Colleges.
- Issues Completion Certificates, who undergo training and qualifies the Online assessment test.
- Participation Certificates shall be issued to the students who undergo the training and do not take the Online test.
- > Provide the promotional materials like posters, brochures, leaflets, banners etc. to the Colleges.

#### General

- This agreement is for duration of Three year from the date of signing and can be renewed and modified from time to time if necessary, based on mutual consent.
- The interpretation of any clause will rest with CCETS, Telangana.
