Objectives:

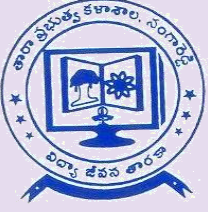
- To train students to use HireMee app for their employment.

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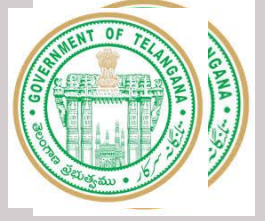


తారా కళాశాలలో కార్యశాల
