I. About the Library

Nothing else is more pleasant than exploring a library. A library usually relies on the library management system to manage asset collections as well as relationships with its stakeholders. Our institution employs an integrated library management system that offers ease of use of library resources (SOUL 3.0) Software for university libraries.

The Department of Library Science is located centrally in the college premises for the convenience of students and staff. The College Library comprises learning resources, i.e., books, periodicals, magazines, and various journals, for use by UG & PG students.

Despite the dawn of e-books and online resources, the necessity of books and the library is relevant even today. The library's services contribute significantly to the development of information services, particularly the e-learning process. Libraries today shoulder new responsibilities in higher education, where classroom teaching plays a facilitating role.

Our college has a central library headed by P. Shankaraiah that is on par with the department libraries existing in the college and is currently serving 3544 students, inclusive of U.G. and P.G. on rolls, and 82 full-time teachers with high-speed internet service, including Wi-Fi provision, to all the students within the library to accomplish their academic purposes.

Our library is ranked No. 2, 2, and 9 at the national level in the months of October 2018, September 2022, and November 2022 in terms of the usage of N-LIST e-resources by faculty and students, which is only an honor with the covetous services of a professional, mature librarian who is passionate about providing library services. Cutting-edge technology is used to access online resources for the information sought. The college enjoys the privilege of the MOU with Kakatiya University Library for the exchange of books and all online resources for the benefit of the college's staff and student community.

The Digital Library is equipped with 26 digital workstations for use by the students and staff, the college library is an institutional member of INFLIBNET (N-LIST), and all the stakeholders of the library are given access to make use of N-LIST services for academics and research. The N-List to access more than 31, 35, 000 e-books and 6,000+ National and International e-journals. User IDs and passwords have been provided to all staff and students to browse the e-resources 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, through remote access; it is also registered with the National Digital Library, which was developed by IIT Kharagpur, to access its digitalized documents.

The Photo Copier facility is arranged for the students to have copies of certain pages of the choice of the books needed on their part. All books are bar-coded. Students and Teachers of this college are readily provided with:

IV. Library Information

Books are for use. All books are kept under Open Access to facilitate students and lecturers. The library has a reference section for ready reference and textbook reading. Reference books like dictionaries, encyclopedias, yearbooks, subject reference books, etc. are available for use within the library. Identified copies of textbooks are kept for reference in the Reference Section.

All the bona fide students admitted to the college as per the nominal rolls are issued textbooks for home reading for a period of 45 days. A renewal facility is provided if the same books are not in demand from other students. Textbooks and reference books are issued to lecturers at regular intervals.

The students are required to produce the College identity card for borrowing books and should return the books before the due date, i.e., within 45 days, to avoid causing inconvenience to other students.
