Parents also suggested that the curriculum needs to be updated periodically with respect to industrial needs.



Most of the alumnae satisfied with co-curricular and extra curricular activities of the college.



Most of the teachers expressed satisfaction for getting trained with ICT tools as they helped in taking online classes during pandemic period.


