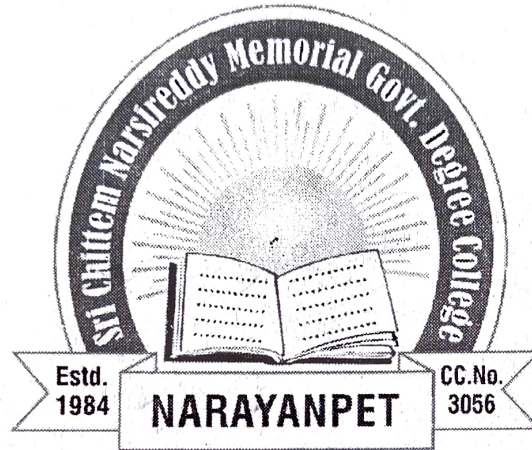

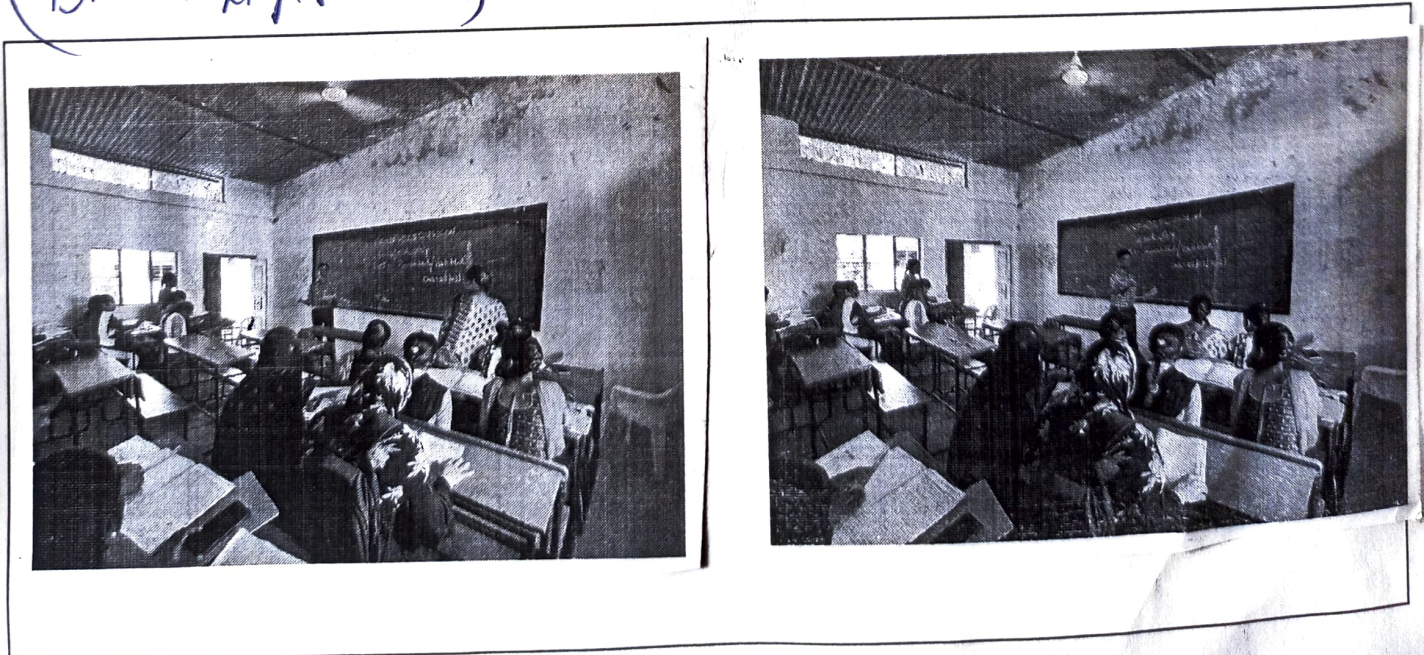
Opinion of the Students: According majority of the students opinion on topic, Agreed that vertebrate animals, evolved from the invertebrate, particularly Haemichordata.
