
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
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












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




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






KU economics professor highlights public role in rescuing economy from Covid-19 fallout




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
'Governments must not ignore education, economy in fight against Covid-19'

Karimnagar, April 23: "The global economy is experiencing a recession due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus pandemic. The impact may prove to be catastrophic on developing and the poor countries," estimated Prof Ravinder Rena, department of Economics, North West University Business School-South Africa, in an online address to students and faculty of the department of Economics at the Government Women's College in Karimnagar on Friday.



The department organised an international webinar titled 'Global Economic Slowdown During The Covid-19 Pandemic: Issues and Challenges' and invited Prof Ravinder Rena to deliver the keynote address.

"The governments should first accord priority for the safety of the people. The hospitals should be strengthened to provide proper medical care to people affected by the deadly virus, while initiating proactive measures to protect their respective economies," he advised.

"The disruption of education, especially in developing countries, which threatens to sideline girl children, is a significant challenge that needs to be attended to along with recouping and rebuilding various sectors of the economy. Governments must accord priority to social security and focus on resolving the problems in the agricultural sector to increase food production," the professor concluded.

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The webinar was organised under the chairmanship of principal T Sreelakshmi; head of the economics department, Markonda Shakuntala along with lecturers P Swaroopa and Irfana Begum. Members of academia and media from across the globe participated in the online event.


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








































Food & Diet (07-04-2021)

Seed balls sit on top of the soil until sufficient rain comes, and then the compost and clay act as nutrients to nourish the emerging seedling. Seed balls are great for throwing out into areas with poor soil since you do not have to plant them.

Method of preparing seedballs explained to the students -15min

Activity Steps (15 min)

1.Students to mix assorted seeds, dry organic compost, and dry clay together in a large bin. Mist or pour a small amount of water onto the bin while continuing to mix. Spray or add just enough water so that the mixture binds together but does not stick to your hands.
