2.2.1 – The Institution assesses the learning levels of the students and organisers special programme for advanced learners and slow learners.

Response:

The students joining in the GDC MEDAK belongs to varied backgrounds with different academic standards. Initially the Institution assesses the learning levels of the newly joined students by conducting subject wise slip test to gauge the previous knowledge in each subject in the chosen programme.

Similarly, Bridge classes are conducted if students from non-commerce background take admission into arts (B.A)

The institution is conscious of the special learning needs of both the advanced learner and the slow learners and responds to them by organising special programme for them.

1. Activities undertaken for advanced learners:

For the advanced learners, special educational programmes such as teacher etc are conducted JIGNASA-Student Study Project is a flagship programme initiated by commissioner of collegiate education(CCE), Telangana state and organised every year at college level, district level & state level. A Group of 5 students under the supervision of a teacher presents study project at various levels. The projects selected for state level competition, the Winners are awarded with an amount of Rs. 30,000/-(25,000/- For students + Rs. 5,000/- for supervisor) and runners are awarded a sum of Rs. 18,000 (15,000/-for students + Rs. 3000/- for supervisor).

Students from Dept. of History won the first prize for the three consecutive years (2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20).

Students from the Dept. of Telugu won 2nd prize for two academic years (i.e. 2017-18 & 2018-19) and won first prize in the year 2019-20.

Students from the Dept. of Political Science won 3rd Prize in the year 2017-18. Advanced learners are allowed to have an access to refer books of the concerned subjects in the library.

Such students are guided to improve their knowledge in the subject further. Organizing group discussions, quiz, Student seminars, assignments etc for them.

The students are encouraged to participate in quiz, elocution, debates, literary competitions at college level, district level & State level also.

In case of second and final year students, they are categorised based on their performance in their previous semester examinations. Every department maintains the marks register with marks scored by each student in all the six semesters.

2. Activities undertaken for slow learners:

Each department conducts remedial classes before the examinations were announced by the university, the slow learners and failed students are identified and registered for the remedial coaching. The important content is revised and previous question papers are practiced by the students. The students are trained in the examination point of view to score good marks in the university examinations.

- Special classes are conducted for slow learners for paying individual attention
- A separate schedule of time table is followed for remedial teaching
- Solving previous year's annual and supplementary examination question papers of the university in the class room itself
- Performance of the students is assessed by conducting tests frequently and the same is intimated to the parents
- Parents are asked to meet the subject teacher in which the student fails to show any improvement
- Such students are motivated to improve their knowledge of the subject further
- Organizing group discussion, mock programmes, quiz etc for them



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
