Geographical Features

Rain water is the major source for the Irrigation needs, which collected from the famous Tank beside the village. This tank water is also utilised for drinking purpose too. Long ago nearly 70 Wells were there, But presently on 12 Wells are functioning in this village. Regarding Canals only 02 are there. There are no Rivers near to this village. Now a days in this village people meets their water needs through the T.S. Govt. programmes like “Mission Bhageeradha”, ”Mission Kakathiya”, etc.,

- Anathsagar village was familiar for “Betel Leaves” farming, which were exported to Bombay during 1990’s. Now a day’s farmers are cultivating Paddy, Cotton, Turmeric, Sugar cane, Leafy vegetables etc..
- Total irrigated area in this village is 50.98 hectares.
- There is no Forest or Hills nearby this village.
- People in this village speaks Telugu, Hindi, Lambadi(Tribal language) , Kannada and English.
- In this village Percentage of Hindu population is 52%
In this village Percentage of Christian population is 26%
In this village Percentage of Hindu population is 22%

In this village no. of temples like Durga temple, Ellamma temple, Katta mysamma temple, Rama temple, Hanuma mandhir etc., are established.

- One Mazid is available.
- Two churches are functioning.
- 3 Durgas are there.



TELANGANA MOVEMENT

In final stage Telangana movement Ch.Ramulu, Anjaneyulu arrested from this village. After formation of Telangana in 2014, Living standards of the people in this village improved such as more than 60% of the village people receiving different types of financial assistance from the Govt. of Telangana, like, Rythu bhandhu, Old age & single women pensions, Kalyana lakshmi etc.. Village infrastructure was also developed drastically like construction of CC roads, Palle prakruthi vanam , varmi compost plant, Creeda maidhanam and vaikuntadhamam etc.,



ECONOMY

- In this village nearly 65 Dwacra groups are functioning.
- One Bank is operating and providing loans to the village people like Home loan, Gold loan and loans to buy cattle also.
- In this village we can find artisans such as Barbers, Dhobi, Pottery makers, Carpenters ect.. Especially a person known as Anjaneyulu family still continuing making of pots in this village from his ancestors.



- In earlier days i.e. when there was no electricity in the village farmers were used to Bullocks to pull water buckets from the tanks and canals for their irrigation needs..Now a days Bore wells, Dig wells and Tanks are using for farming needs.
- In this village Dairy, Sheep, Bulls, Cows, Fishery and Poultry industry are performing very good ..
- The electricity facility was provided in 1987 for the school in the village.
- Street lights were established in this village in early 1970's itself.
- "Palle prakruthivanam"(village garden) is there for kids recreation.
- Ananthasagar village people celebrates festivals like Ramjan,Kristmas, Peerlu, Bhathukamma, Mohurm, Bonalu Jathara and Mallanna Jathara etc..
- Mallaiah who knew the history of the village in Ananthasagar.
- Rural sanitation system is well organised.Harithavanam also well maintained in this village.
- The living conditions are enhanced after Telangana formation. Peoople from different articians are good..

Historical Aspects

- Previous name of Ananthasagar is “Suryapeta”. Ananthasagar has huge Tank which spreads nearly 360 Acres area. Due to this only this village named as Ananthasagar late days..
- In Ananthasagar we may find Lord Venkateswara temple, Hanuman mandhir, Masque, Church are functioning.

Church in this village was started in 1982.

It was established nearly 100 years ago.





- Two “Boorju’s” were found in this village.
- The main occupation of the villagers is Agriculture and some people working in small scale industries which are located near to the village.
