### VOTER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN TO SENSITIZE VOTERS AND CANDIDATES ACADEMIC YEAR (2017-2018)

#### Background:-

After decentralization of power, the Panchayats, in all it's three stages plays a crucial role in the over all socio-economic development of people as well as the nation. Over the years lots of Function, Fund and Functionaries has been delegated to the panchayats. In Telangana State where most of people live in rural areas, local bodies have gained significant importance in the decentralization process as people have the authority to make their development projects. Crores of money are pumped into the panchayats with enormous power for infrastructure and livelihood development of people. However, rampant corruption is seen in the local bodies due to ignorance of common people and the lack of honest and effective elected representatives to lead the development work. The elections are dominated by money and muscle power. Hence, the much desired overall development through panchayats is yet be realized. Keeping this in view, Sri Chittem Narsi Reddy Memorial Governament Degree College, Narayanpet decided to launch a campaign called

" Voter Awareness Compaign" in Near by Villages of Narayanpet town.

#### Objectives of campaign:

- To creating awareness among the people/public/voter regarding the importance of the three tier local electoral system
- To enhance people's participation in the voting system
- To create awareness to select effective people centric leaders
- To ensure smooth implementation/execution of our planned activities
- To get pre-election commitment from contesting candidates

#### Activities carried out during the campaign:

**Printing of cloth banners:** There will be cloth banner which will mention the importance of Panchayat & General Elections. The banner will also have section where it will be written that people promise to elect honest and effective candidates. It will be displayed during village meetings and at local haats and people will be requested to sign on the banners.

**Signature on Declaration Paper:** The need was felt to make the candidates answerable and accountable to the voters before being elected. Therefore, it was decided to get written commitments (declaration paper) from

the candidates, where the candidates will write down in a paper to perform certain things after they win the elections. Sample declaration paper was circulated among our villagers for the same.

**Orientation for Self Help Group (SHG) and Youth Clubs:** During the village meeting it was decided to involve the community based organizations like the SHGs and youth clubs of the villages to spread the importance of the Voting and for free and fair elections.

**Street Play:** Street Plays have a crucial role in disseminating information to the larger public through the means of entertainment. So it was decided to perform street plays regularly in crowded places. The script and dialogues of the play was decided keeping in mind the local context and our campaign objectives.

#### Highlights of the action:

- The campaign was conducted in 5 villages of Narayanpet District.
- The campaign reached out to nearly 5000 people through village meetings
- A total of 150 citizens signed on cloth banners from 5 villages
- One street play was performed in Thipraspalli Villages districts where more than 400 people witnessed and got the message of our campaign objectives

#### Outcome of the action:

Panchayat elections are the most sensitive elections in a state, The Voter Awareness compaign by the college students was succeeded inspiring many youth and other people towards utilizing their Votes.

The process of voter awareness through the campaign has certainly helped even if in a small way to strengthen local governance. Voters were able to get the message on the need of good governance at panchayat& general level through visual and verbal methods during street plays and village meetings. It helped in informed voting. The elected candidates were made accountable even prior to the elections.

The essence of true democracy was realized when people directly questioned their candidates. Candidates were able to internalize responsibility before & after election. Apart from that, lots of common masses got to know about the roles & responsibility of Elected members. In the process of the campaign, a relationship was also built with the elected Members and other candidates who lost out in the elections.


