


Ms. S. Sarada Devi ended the event with a call to join the movement called 'green living' which motivates people to adopt an environmentally friendly way of living.


Eminent Chartered Accountant, Sri Amit Garg, and Sri Devaraja Reddy, the ex-president of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India were the resource persons. Professor of Commerce, Prof. V Appa Rao also participated in the event. They elaborated the Indian Accounting Standard (abbreviated as Ind-AS), the Accounting standard adopted by companies in India and issued

under the supervision of Accounting Standards Board (ASB) which was constituted as a body in the year 1977. ASB is a committee under Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) which consists of representatives from government department, academicians, other professional bodies viz. ICAI, representatives from ASSOCHAM, CII, FICCI, etc. ICAI is an independent body formed under an act of parliament.

The resource persons mentioned that the Ind AS are named and numbered in the same way as the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS). This shall be applied to the companies of financial year 2015-16 voluntarily and from 2016-17 on a mandatory basis.

The event was attended by 30 students and 3 faculty members of the college. Ms. S. Sarada Devi coordinated this online event. She spoke at the end of the event and said that such programs benefit the students as they become aware of the latest accounting practices and procedures. They gain practical knowledge. The principal, Dr. Ch. RamaRaju spoke and appreciated the commerce department for organizing such a prestigious event participated by eminent chartered accountants and commerce professors.



Add seeds, take small bits of the clay mixture and roll into ball about one inch in diameter. Dry seed balls for 24-48 hours in a shady place before sowing or storing. The last step in how to make flower seed balls is sowing them.











II. A BRIEF REPORT

The guest speaker gave an elaborate lecture on the topic. He said that probability is the branch of mathematics/statistics concerning numerical descriptions of how likely an event is to occur, or how likely it is that a proposition is true. The probability of an event is a number between 0 and 1, where, roughly speaking, 0 indicates impossibility of the event and 1 indicates certainty. The higher the probability of an event, the more likely it is that the event will occur. A simple example is the tossing of a fair (unbiased) coin. Since the coin is fair, the two outcomes ("heads" and "tails") are both equally probable; the probability of "heads" equals the probability of "tails"; and

since no other outcomes are possible, the probability of either "heads" or "tails" is 1/2 (which could also be written as 0.5 or 50%).

He spoke about the importance of probability topic to Commerce students. He solved many problems from the textbook. In the Q & A session, the resource person answered all the queries posed by the students. The event concluded with the felicitation of the guest and a vote of thanks proposed by N. Bala, Assistant professor of Commerce.


