The academic standing of such students shall be determined by both the institutions. Exchange of Faculty and students will be accorded the rights and privileges of students in accordance with the regulations of both the institutions relating to students and will be admitted under the terms and conditions relevant to their standing instructions in vogue. Accreditation for the academic work carried out by an undergraduate student during the period of study shall be decided on mutual understanding for the benefit of the students.

The aim of the Memorandum of this Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both the institutions.
