- conduct short term courses/ value added courses/add-on courses/field projects/ internships, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of the activity;
- conduct environmental/academic/sports and games /cultural projects, a, mutually agreed memorandum in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity;
- conduct study tours, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.

2. Facilitate the exchange of Faculty and undergraduate students. Such exchanges may take place for a period normally agreeable to both the institutions without any detriment to the academics of the students in their course study. The academic standing of such students shall be determined by both the institutions. Exchange of Faculty and students will be accorded the rights and privileges of students in accordance with the regulations of both the institutions relating to students and will be admitted under the terms and conditions relevant to their standing instructions in vogue. Accreditation for the academic work carried out by an undergraduate student during the period of study shall be decided on mutual understanding for the benefit of the students.

The aim of the Memorandum of this Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both the institutions.
