#### 1. NAAC Accreditation

a. The institution has undergone NAAC accreditation process in this academic year. The peer team visited the campus on 26/10/21 and 27/10/21. The institution was awarded with NAAC – B grade. It is a great achievement for a small college with limited resources.

#### 2. Infrastructure and ICT

- a. The library has been revamped with installation of computers and access to free online journals has been given to students.
- b. New science laboratory block has been inaugurated and and all the science departments have been shifted to the new facility.
- c. A class room has been converted into a seminar hall for the purpose of seminars and meetings.
- d. Virtual class room setup is installed in the college. The contract of Maintenance services of the setup are renewed with an amount of rs.50,000
- e. Both the computer labs are equipped with wired internet and wifi connections.
- f. CCTV surveillance in the campus is in place.
- g. Faculty are encouraged to use ICT facilities available in the college and are instructed to create e-content for the use of students to be uploaded to the college website.a
- h. A small dais is constructed in the premises of the college with the funds generated by Alumni association

- a. Mid day Meal: despite severe shortage of funds and COVID related restrictions, Mid-day meal has been implemented in the college throughout the year.
- b. Admissions Campaign: to increase the number of admissions, the IQAC has devised the admission campaign. The faculty members visited the surrounding villages and conducted campaign.

a. Due to the second wave of COVID-19, the institutions have not been opened for physical mode of classes until October 21. Hence, all the teachers are instructed to conduct online classes. Live classes on zoom and recorded classes on youtube are made available for the students.

- a. Student our institution have participated in JIGNASA state level student study project competition organized by the CCE. Entries from all the subjects were sent to the selection committee.
- b. Project works of English, Hindi and History were selected for state level presentation.


A detailed analysis of each statement given in the feedback form was done, based on the responses given by the students. The below given table presents the rating of the students in percentages.


