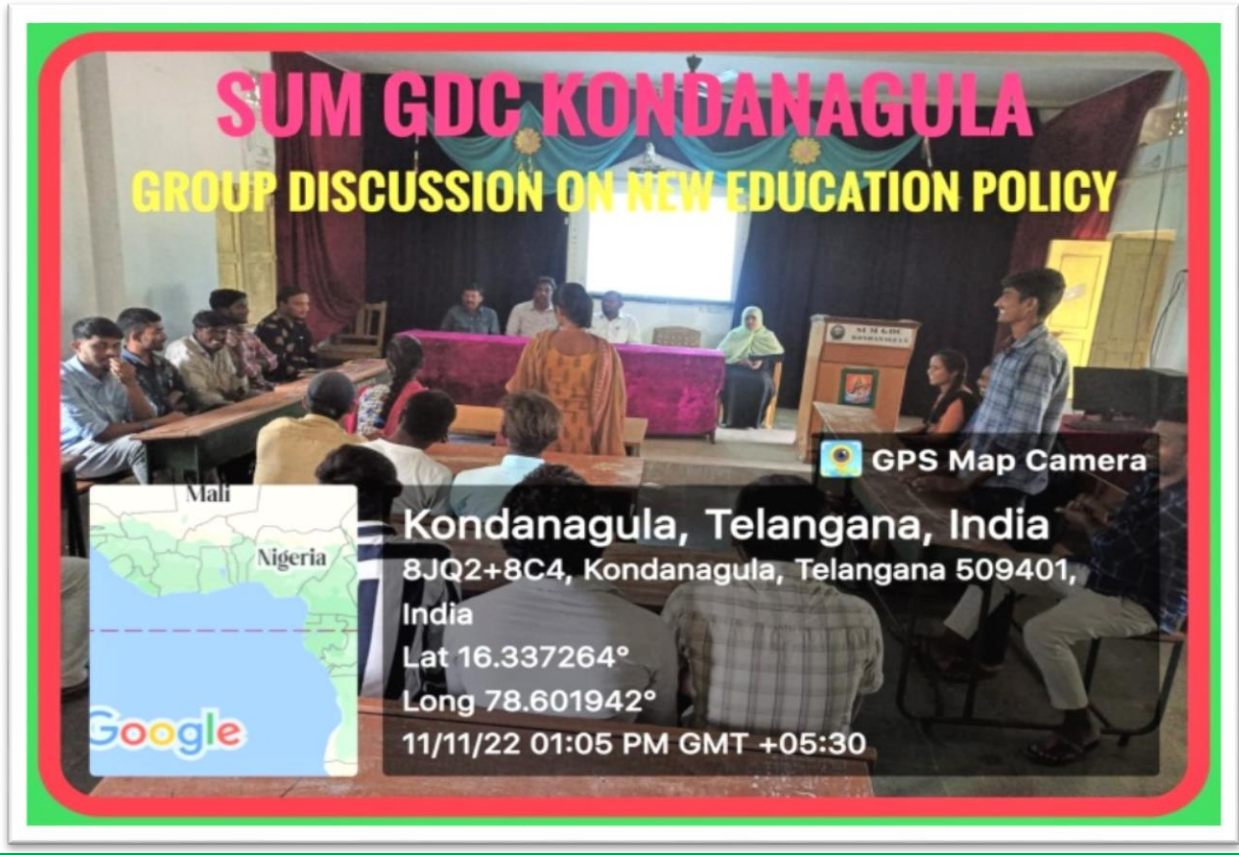

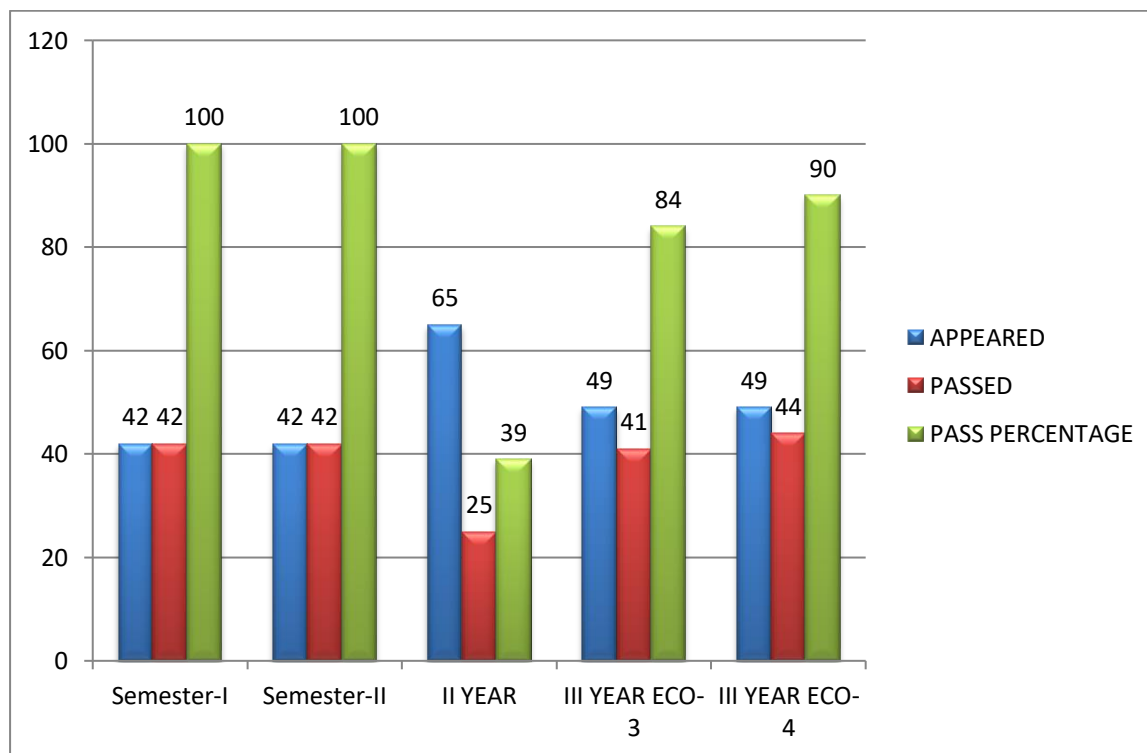

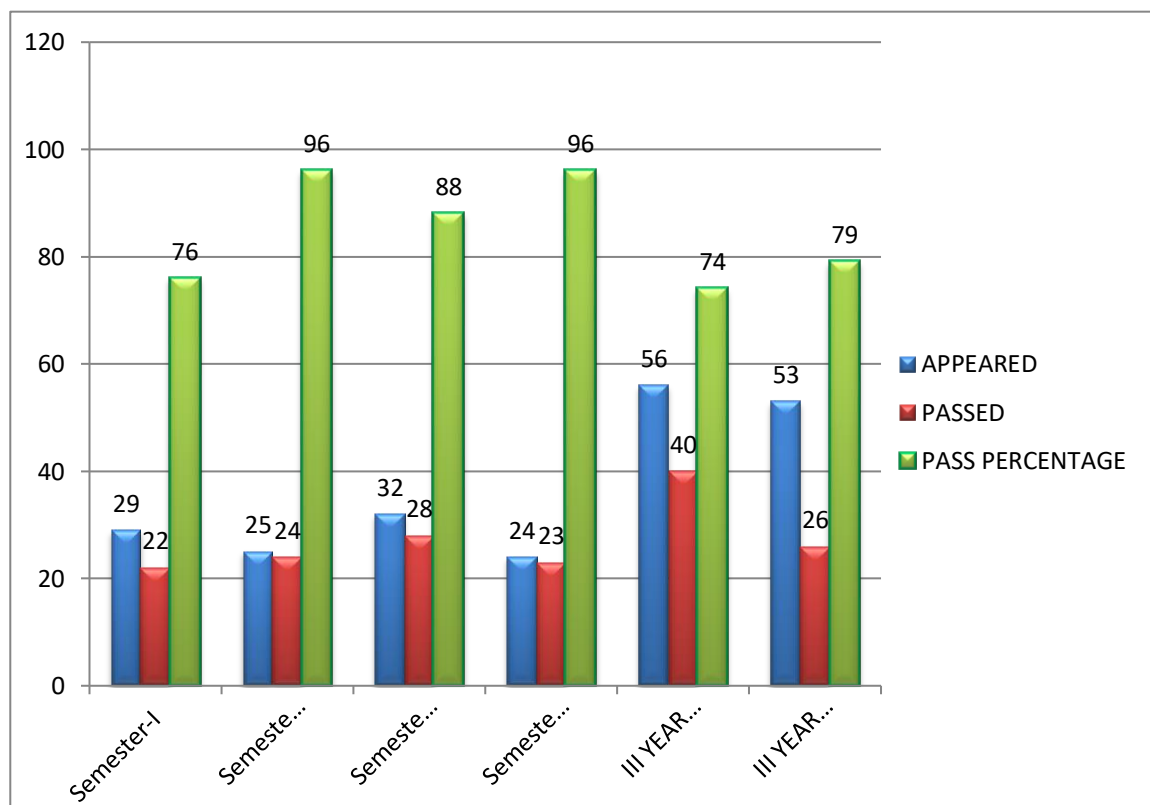
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2016-17 RESULTS

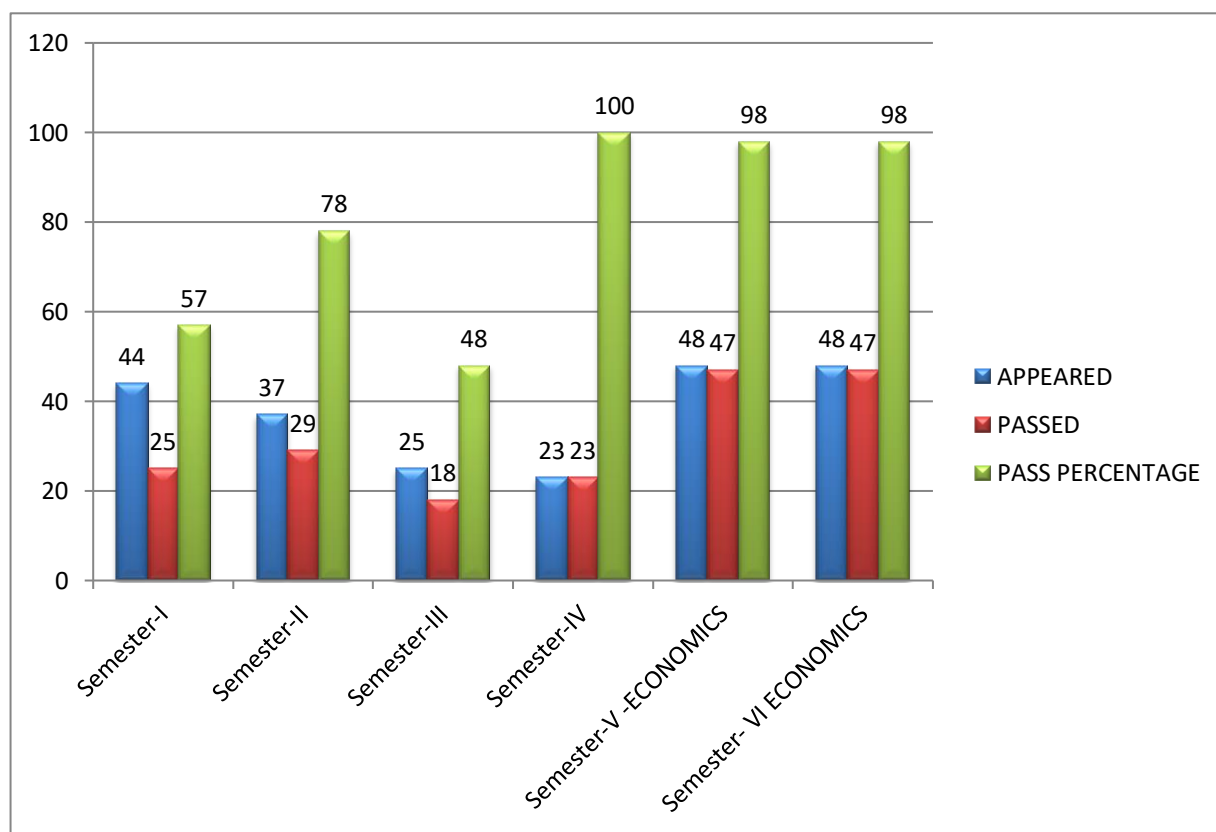
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2017-18 RESULTS

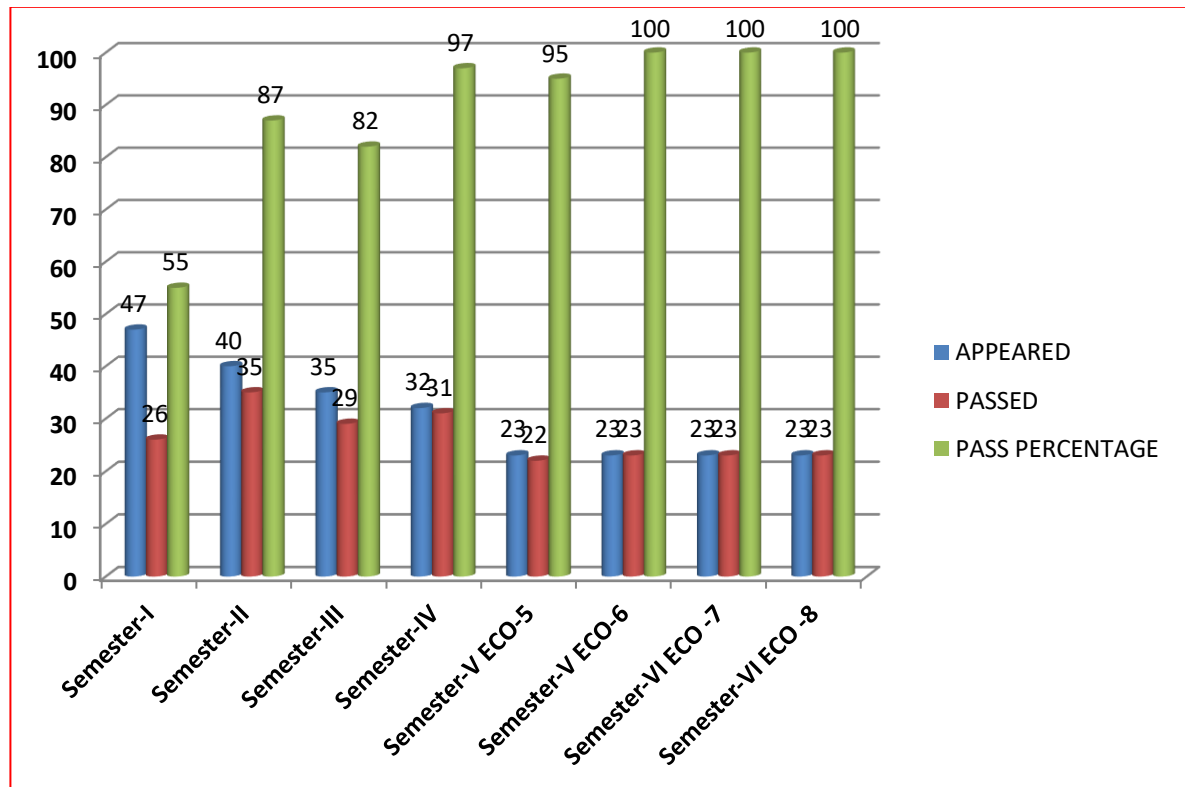
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2018-19 RESULTS

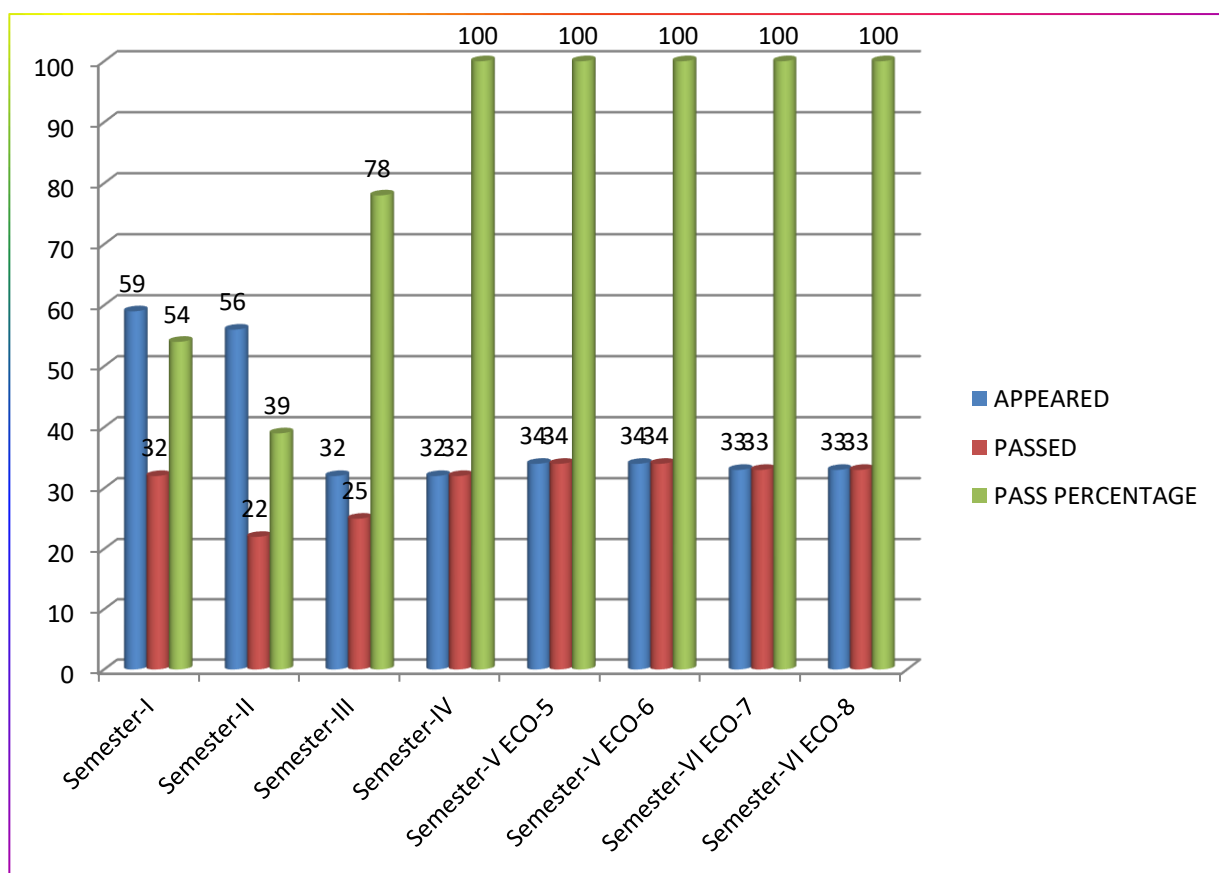
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2019-20 RESULTS

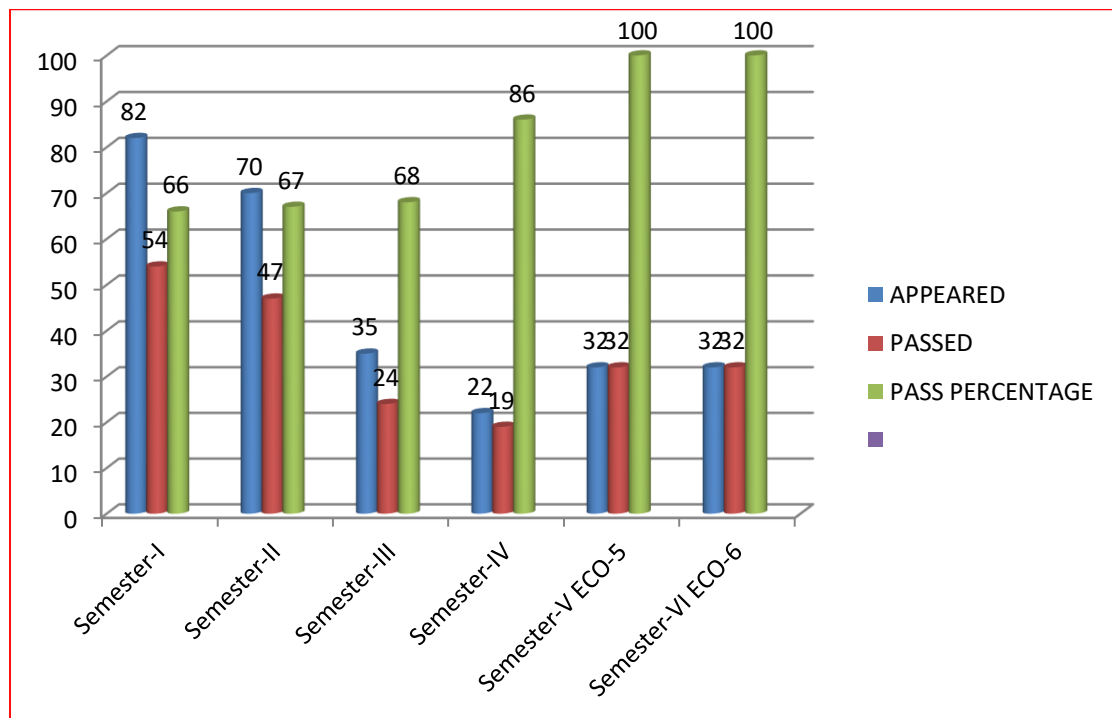
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2020-21 RESULTS

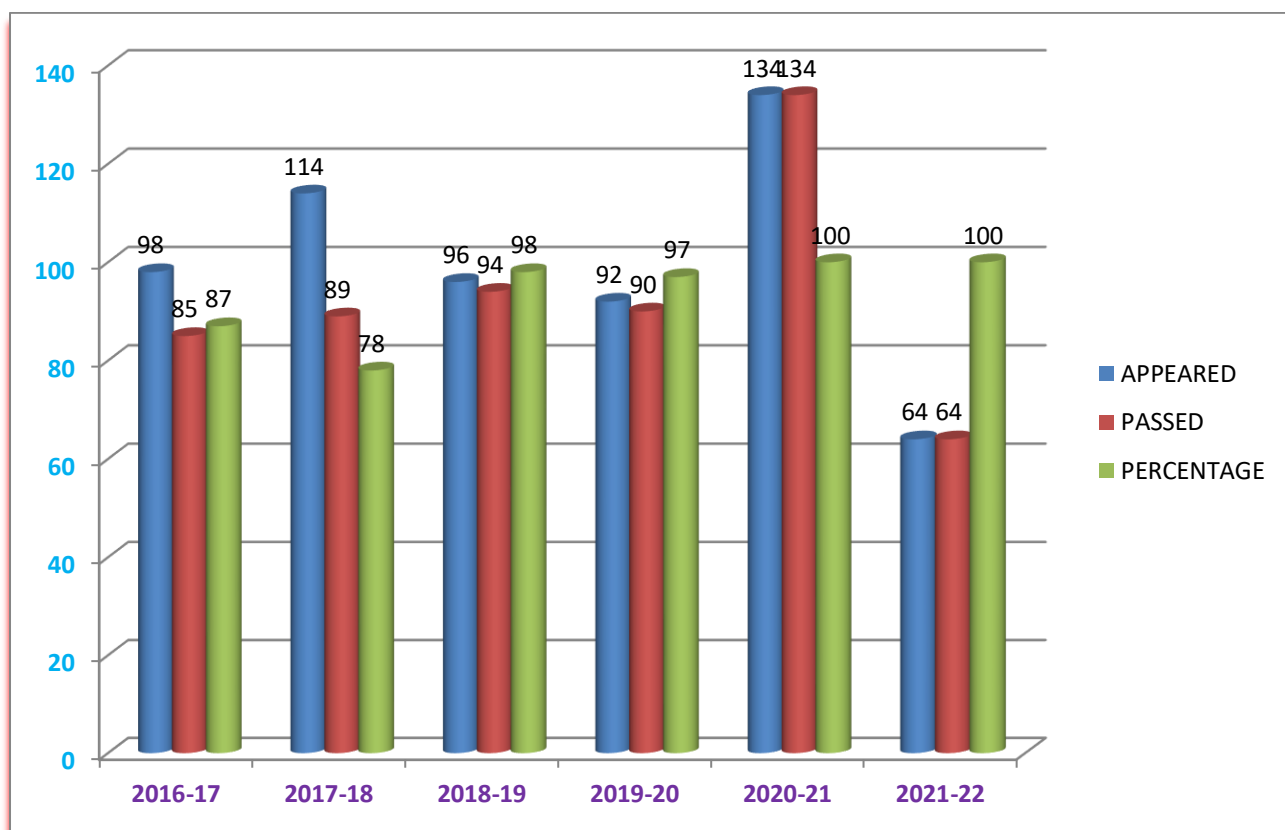
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2021-22. RESULTS

GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF OVERAL YEAR WISE RESULT ANALYSIS FROM 2016-17 TO 2021-22.



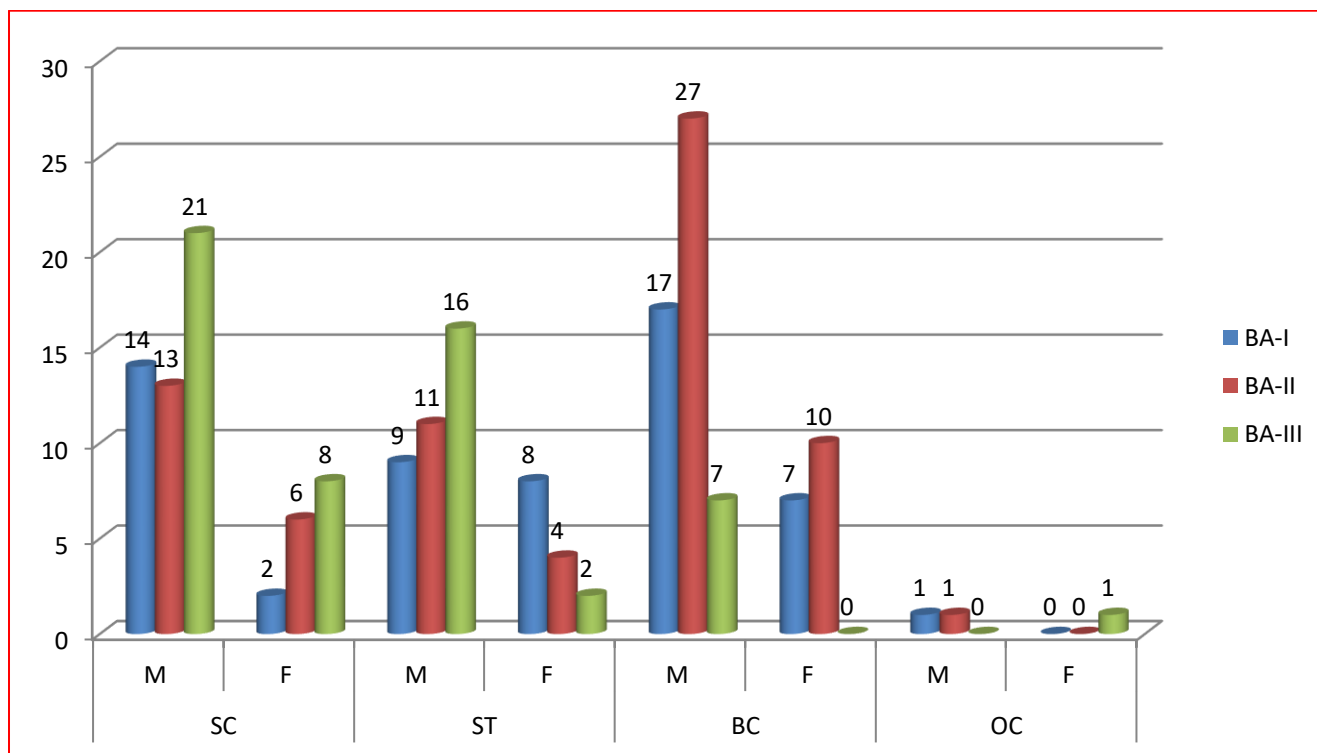

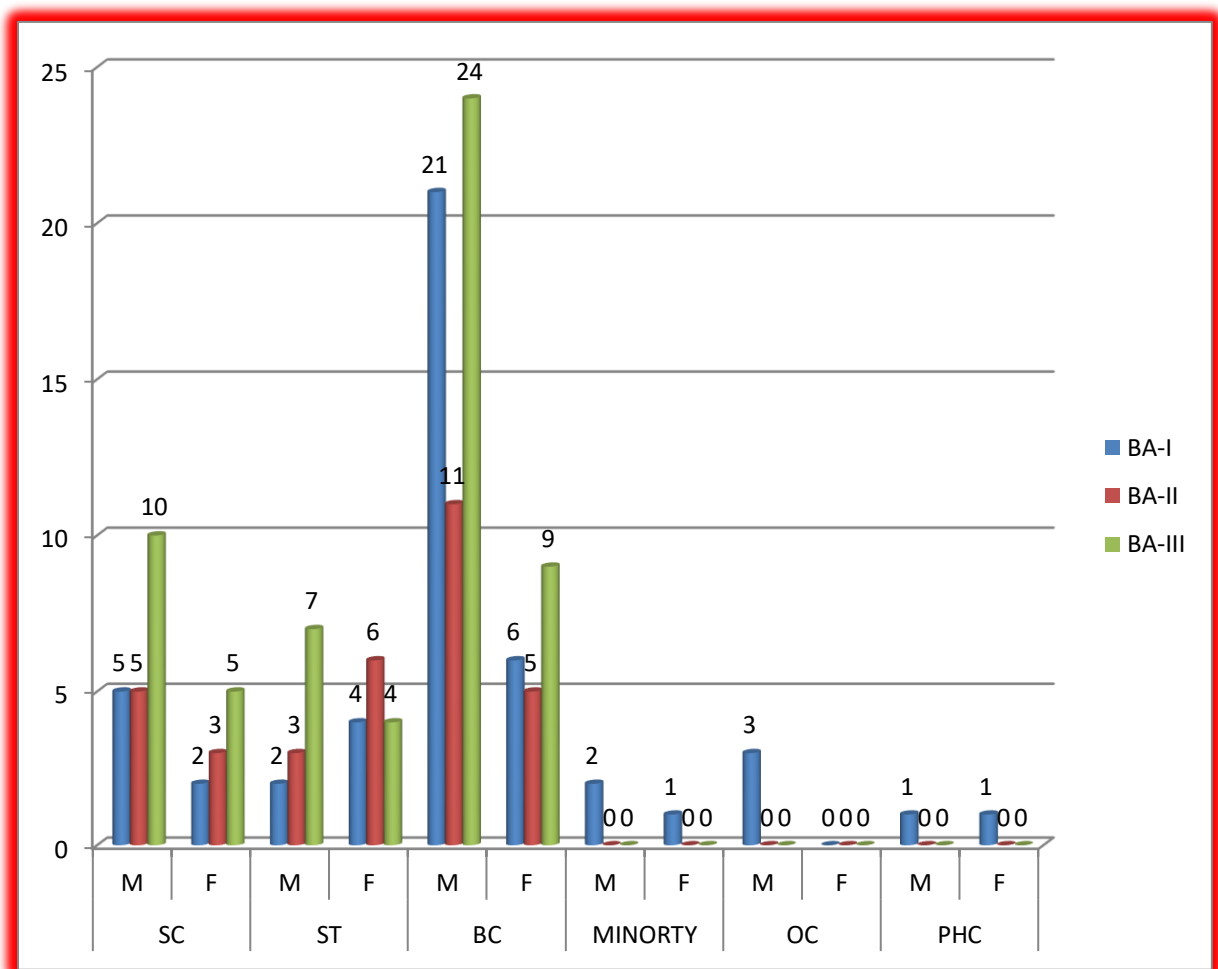
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SOCIAL STATUS 2016-17

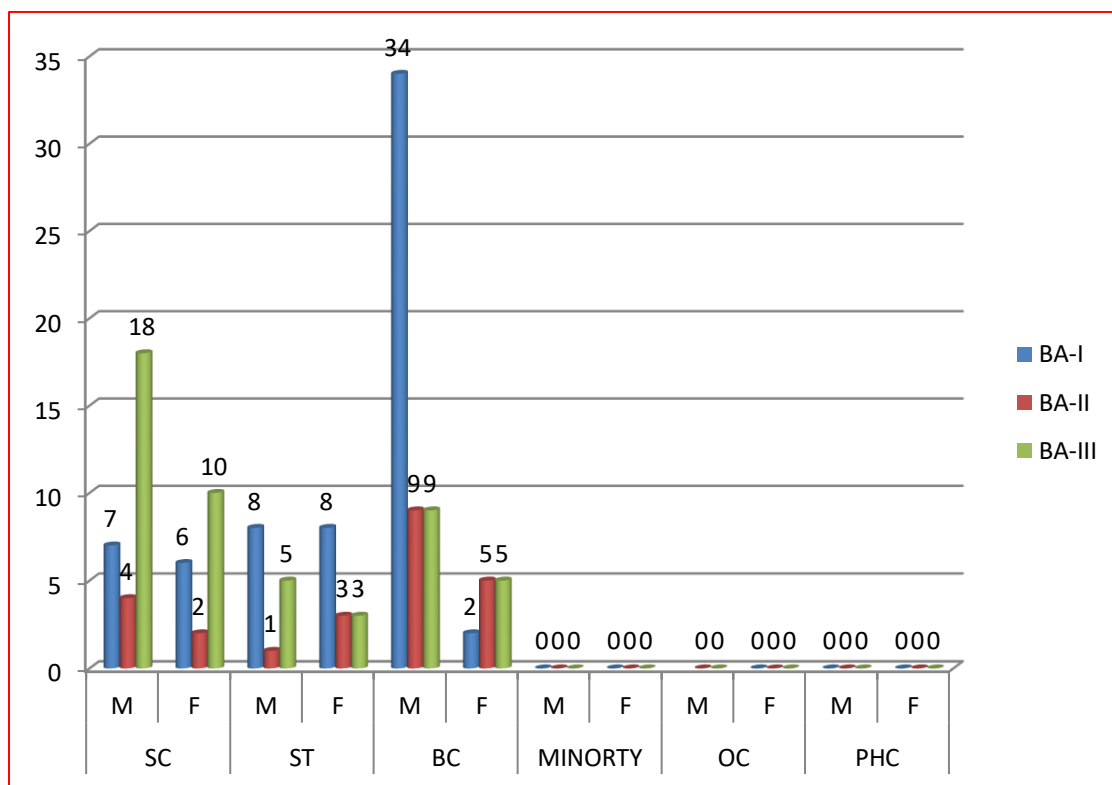
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SOCIAL STATUS 2017-18

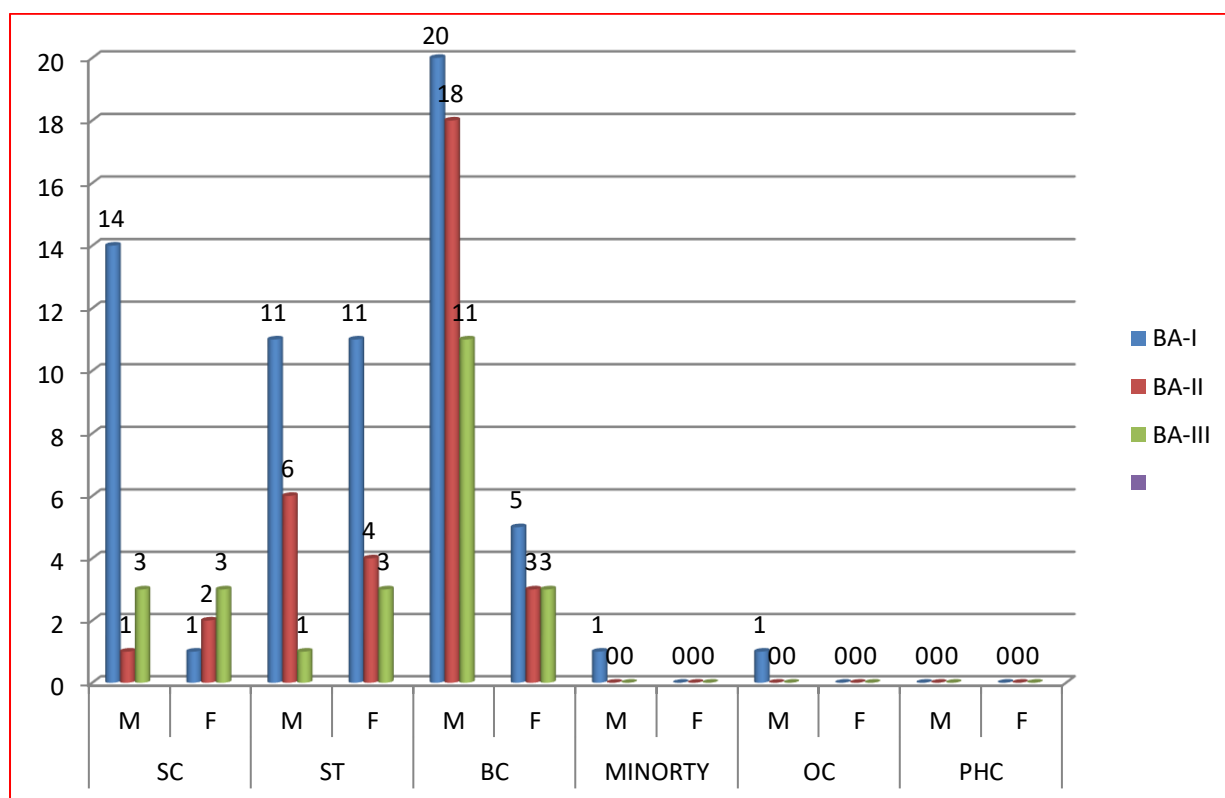
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SOCIAL STATUS 2018-19

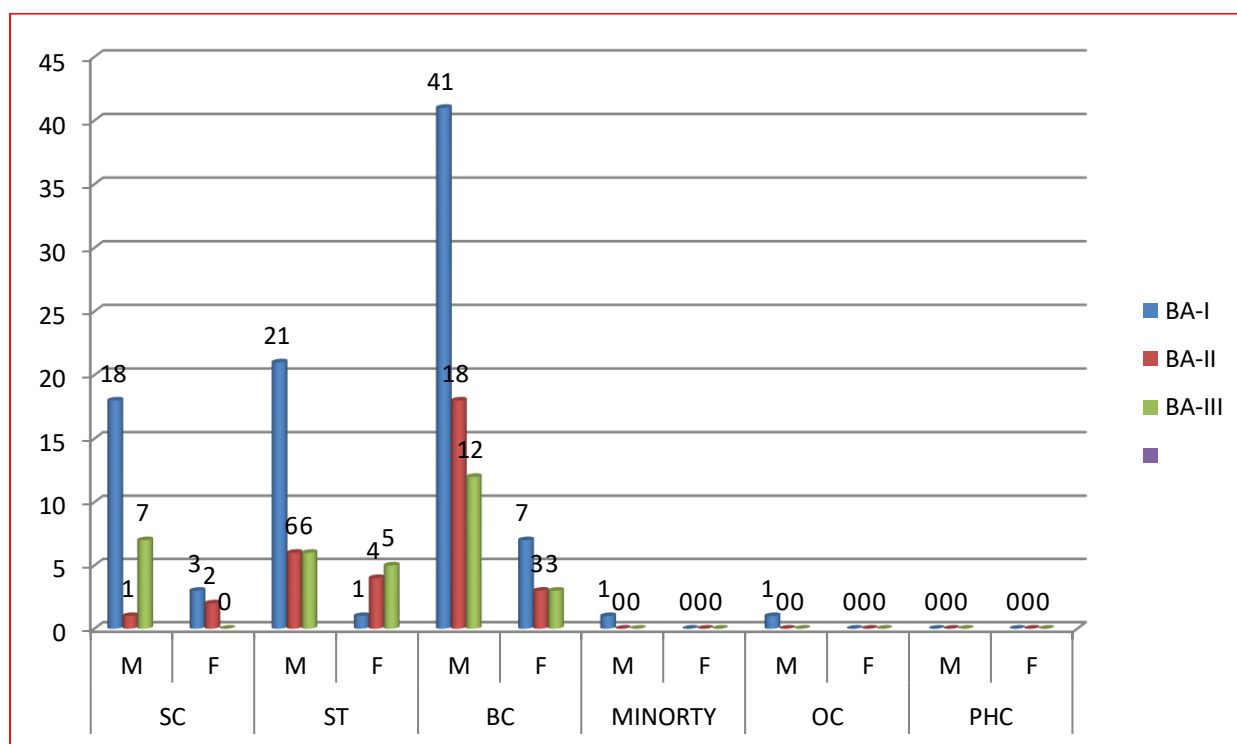
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SOCIAL STATUS 2019-20

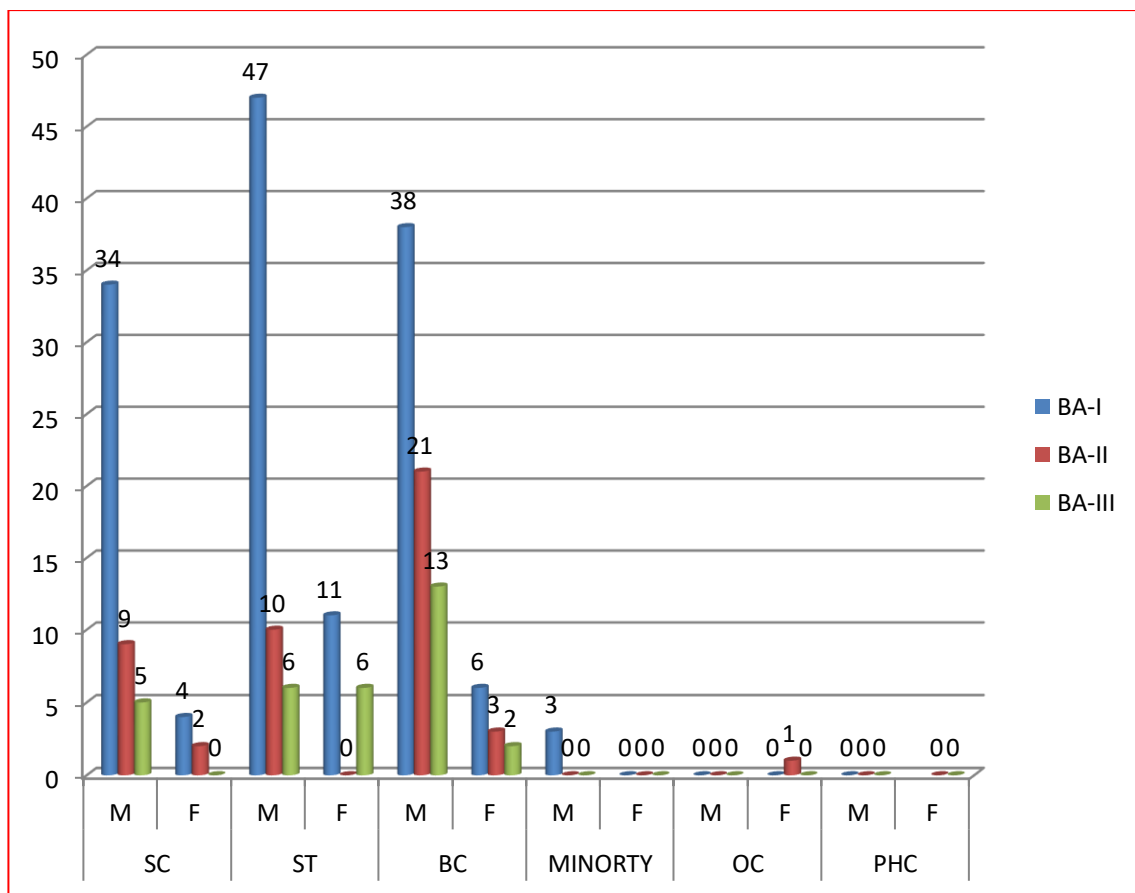
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SOCIAL STATUS 2020-21

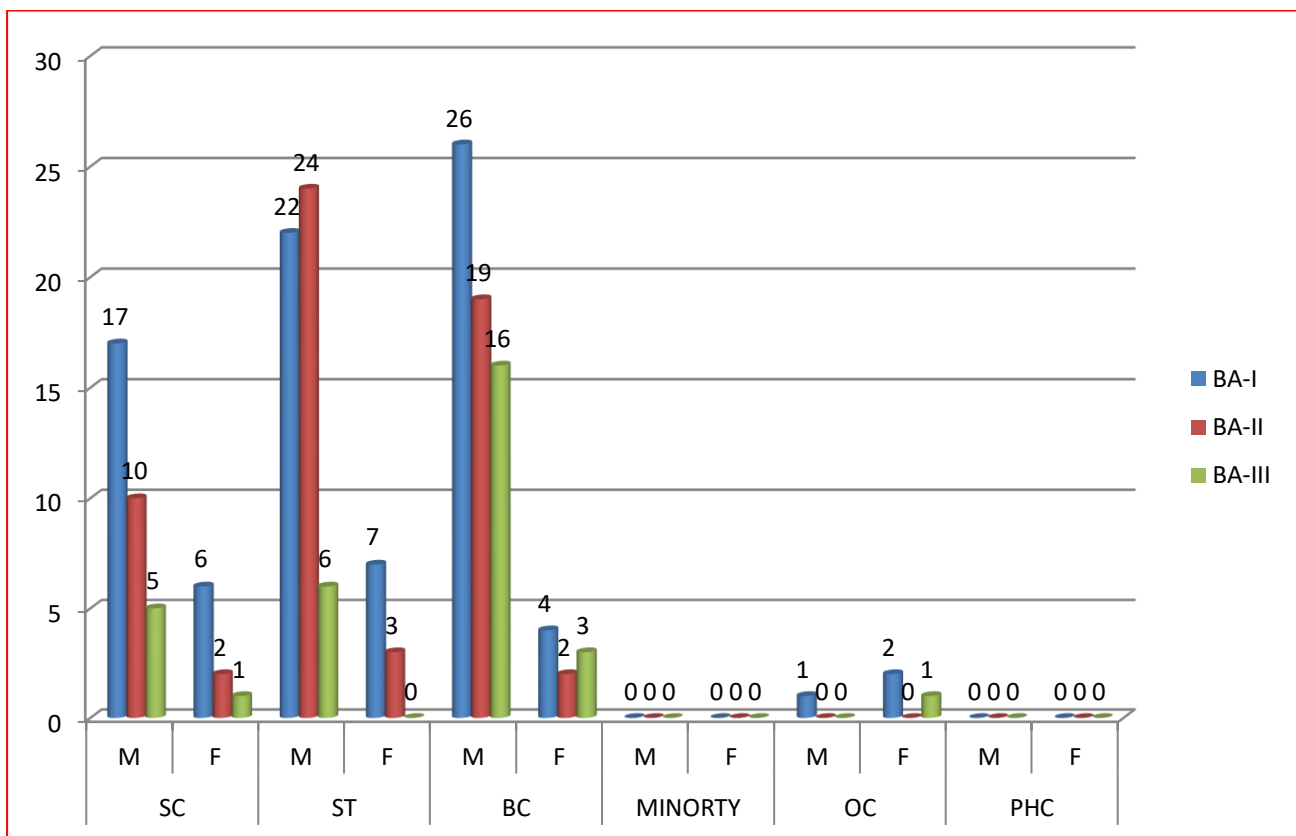
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF SOCIAL STATUS 2021-22
