II. A BRIEF REPORT

The Department of Commerce organized an extension lecture on 22 December 2021 by Mr. A. Narendra Chary of Kranthi Degree College, Konda Mallepally.

Mr. A. Narendra Chary gave an extensive lecture on final accounts. He explained the preparation of final accounts of a firm. He solved many problems in the class, explaining in detail every step in the process.

He first explained the difference between a Trading A/c and Profit & Loss Account. He detailed the entries made in both the accounts. He pointed out that Trading A/c shows gross profit and P & L A/c shows net profit.

The resource person also explained the concept and preparation of the balance sheet. He said that it depicts the financial position of a company in that year. By reading the balance sheet, the stakeholders get an idea about the assets and liabilities of the company.

The Q & A session was lively with students asking questions about different problems they encountered during the preparation of final accounts. The resource person gave techniques of solving the problems. Mr. N. Bala ended the event by proposing the vote of thanks. The Principal, Dr. Ch. RamaRaju and students participated in the event making it a success.

II. A BRIEF REPORT

An extension lecture was organized by the department of Commerce for B. Com. II year students. The resource person was Mr. M. Satyanarayana, Lecturer in Commerce, Kranthi Degree College, Konda Malllepally. The topic was probability.

Mr.N.Bala, Assistant professor of Commerce gave a speech introducing the guest and welcoming everybody. He then handed over the proceedings to Mr. M. Satyanarayana.

The guest speaker gave an elaborate lecture on the topic. He said that probability is the branch of mathematics/statistics concerning numerical descriptions of how likely an event is to occur, or how likely it is that a proposition is true. The probability of an event is a number between 0 and 1, where, roughly speaking, 0 indicates impossibility of the event and 1 indicates certainty. The higher the probability of an event, the more likely it is that the event will occur. A simple example

is the tossing of a fair (unbiased) coin. Since the coin is fair, the two outcomes ("heads" and "tails") are both equally probable; the probability of "heads" equals the probability of "tails"; and since no other outcomes are possible, the probability of either "heads" or "tails" is $1/2$ (which could also be written as 0.5 or 50%).

He spoke about the importance of probability topic to Commerce students. He solved many problems from the textbook. In the Q & A session, the resource person answered all the queries posed by the students. The event concluded with the felicitation of the guest and a vote of thanks proposed by N. Bala, Assistant professor of Commerce.



KRANZ ANATOMY :

[German ; Kranz = wreath = ring]

- **Haberland (1884)**
- The vascular bundles are surrounded by a layer of parenchyma cells known as bundle sheath cells that separate them from mesophyll cells.
