



Report on educational tour to visit Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology Introduction:

CCMB is one premier research institute in India located in Hyderabad, Telangana. The Centre for Cellular & Molecular Biology (CCMB) is a premier research organization in frontier areas of modern biology. The objectives of the Centre are to conduct high quality basic research and training in frontier areas of modern biology, and promote centralized national facilities for new and modern techniques in the inter-disciplinary areas of biology. CCMB was started initially as a semi-autonomous Centre on April 1, 1977 with the Biochemistry Division of the then Regional Research Laboratory (presently, Indian Institute of Chemical Technology, IICT) Hyderabad forming its nucleus and Dr P M Bhargava heading the new Centre. Earlier, the Governing Board of the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) New Delhi, the apex body which constituted 44 research institutions in the country, approved the proposal in 1976 to establish such a Centre in view of the importance of research in the frontier and multi-disciplinary areas of modern biology.

It is providing

- Training to the people in the advanced areas of biology to serve the needs of development
 in these areas, with special provision for short-term training of staff from other institutions
 in techniques for which adequate facilities may not exist elsewhere.
- Centralized facilities in the country for new and modern techniques in the inter-disciplinary areas of biology, and to ensure that these facilities are so organized, maintained and administered that they can be put to maximal use by research workers from other laboratories and institutions in the country.

 Providing the major research breakthroughs the field of science for betterment of society especially medicinal, agricultural, pathological areas.

Objectives of the tour:

- To give exposure to the students to research labs
- To inculcate the research attitude among the students
- To know the current research and developments in the science.
- To know the knowledge about recent technologies developed in and outside the CCMB.
- To encourage the students towards the science.
- This program also encourages the students to think in analytical way.

Students of B.Sc III yr, M.B.C (Microbiology, Botany and Chemistry) and B.Z.C (Botany, Zoology and Chemistry) along with the Sri Ramachandram, Assistant Professor of Microbiology, of Government Degree College, Gajwel has planned to visit the CCMB on its Silver Jubilee day i.e on 06 September 2017. A total of 40 student's were participated in the educational tour and visited the CCMB.

The guide explained about the equipment present in the different labs. The students are basically from Microbiology background. They visited Microscope facility lab and guide explained the different advanced version microscopes and its advantages.







