TITLE OF THE PRACTICE: "Collection of telugu folk literature"

THE OBJECTIVES:

➤ THE CONTEXT

There are two types of Telugu literature. The first is folklore, the second is classical literature. Folklore is created by illiterate paupers while classical literature is created by scholars. Folk Literature mirrors the sentiments of folk. Reflects folk culture. Folk Literature is a major component of folklore. Literature consists of 1) folk poetry 2) folk tales 3) folk language 4) proverbs 5) thrift stories. The purpose of this practice is to collect and preserve the hidden folklore by the students and to inform them of its significance.

THE PRACTICE

Students get practice on the following way : Writing and presenting a day of proverbs collected by students on the blackboard. Practice by listening to the songs and stories they collect and telling them to the rest of the class in their classroom.

Developing language skills through the use of proverbs in everyday business.
