- In the recent outbreak of corona virus globally to secure from its attack vaccination programme has been done in the college. All the students and faculty have been vaccinated in this programme.

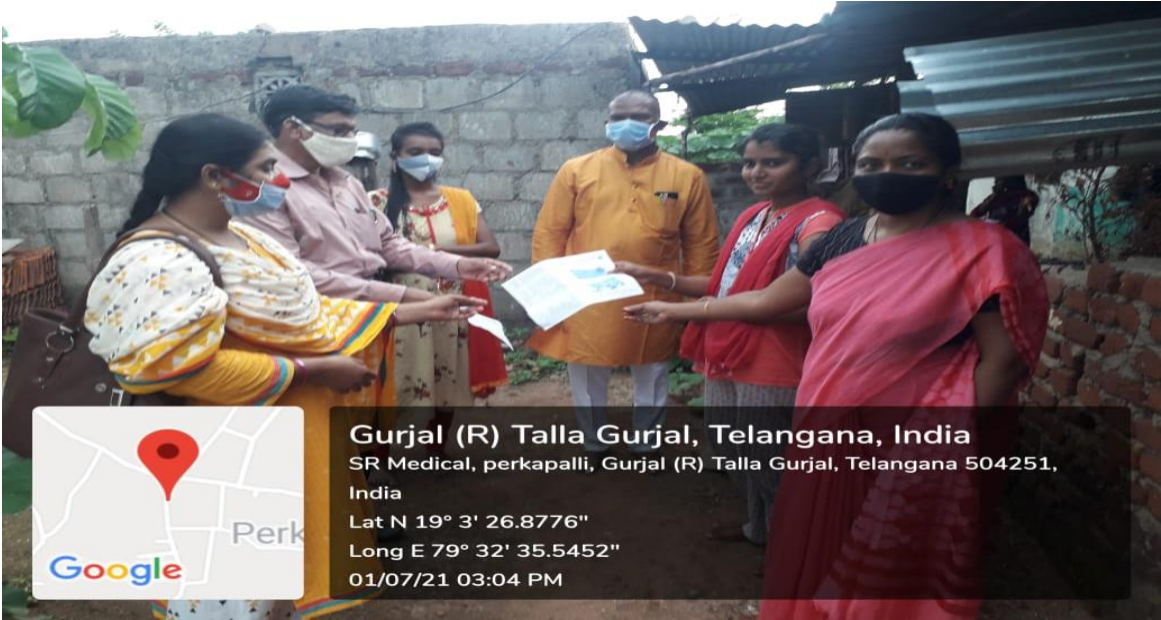

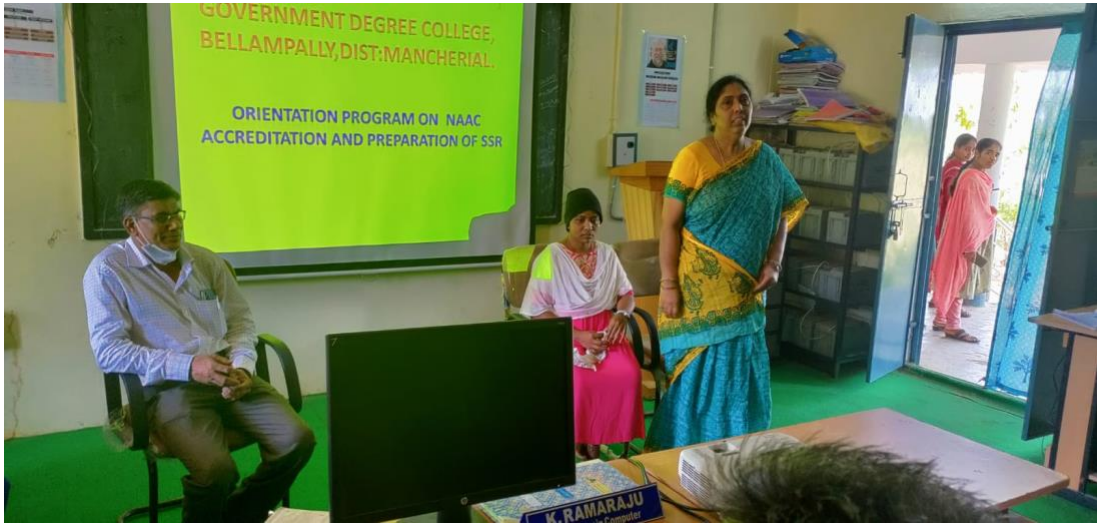
