The Process of making new words from a base or root form without anything attached to it, which you will find in a dictionary is known as word formation.

Since English is a derivational language, it has borrowed many words from other languages from Greek and Latin roots.

For ex: pater (or patr) is a Latin word meaning father.

It serves as the root for English words such as patriarch, patrimony, patron, patricide, patriarchal - - -

It is possible to make out the meanings of words if we know the meanings of root words. Learning at least 2 word roots a day can help the student fetch a lot of vocabulary. maintaining a small pocket notebook can even be at hand when ever needed.
