FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT



The feedback collected from the stake hoders is analyzed to identify the gaps, weaknesses and strengths of the curriculum offered, with a view to strengthen the teaching -learning process and environment. The analysis report of the feedback collected for the academic year 2020-21 has been summarized based on the data enumerated through distribution of response sheets (with six parameters). The questionnaire is framed on the aspects as syllabus, content of the syllabus; its applicability and relevance to the societal needs; its usefulness in pursuing higher studies and so on. On the whole, almost all stakeholders are content with the curriculum and the structure of the course.

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


