Profile of the College

Government Degree College, Rangasaipet, Warangal, was founded in 2008 to meet the aspirations of people of Rangasaipet and the neighboring areas for higher education. The College is located in Warangal, a historic city that was once the seat of the Kakatiya emperors. The college is affiliated with K.U., Warangal, and the University Grants Commission in New Delhi has granted its 2(f) status. This college offers Undergraduate Programs (UG (NP)) in B.A (History, Economics, and Political Science), B.Com (Computers), and B.Sc. (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, and Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Computers) with an intake of 60 per course and a science intake of 50 per course admissions. To Scaling up undergraduate education through a new Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) and time-relevant courses in response to demand and supply, as well as adopting a consistent vision of curricular syllabi to keep up with changing trends in higher education. The college is progressing at an accelerated pace to accomplish its goals & objectives. Though it is a co-educational college, the admission ratio of female students is greater than that of boys as it is the only government college in the Rangasaipet area. The college has a well-defined vision and mission, which is reflected in its various curricular and co-curricular activities. Its ambition is to educate, enrich, and empower rural students to become fully qualified graduates, to foster a global perspective, and to sensitize them to face global competitiveness through value-based education. It is surrounded by boy's hostels for scheduled castes and tribes, as well as a residential junior college. Classrooms at the college are large and well-ventilated.

The faculty at the college is highly qualified, with a strong academic record and extensive teaching experience. Out of 14 regular teaching faculty 07 of them have Ph.Ds, 1 has an M.Phil, and 3 are pursuing PhDs, in addition to the 03 NET- qualified and 02 SET- qualified. All of the faculty members are young and dynamic individuals who are eager to enlighten students with their valuable contributions. Regardless of their diverse programmes, the students are personally known by their names to all concerned faculty members. Students are open to speak about their personal problems and finding advice from the staff. To supplement the institutional curriculum, the college is planning to implement a number of innovative programmes. By involving students in a variety of activities, the teaching and learning process becomes more student-centered. Students are being taught about gender equality and many more. Male and female students participate equally in all social activities, with no regard to gender. Cultural activities are given top priority. The students compete in the "Yuvatarangam," a state-wide literary and cultural competition involving all of the government degree colleges and organised by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana. In order to instill a research mindset in students, study projects are undertaken with their participation. Students at the college are encouraged to participate in sports and games as well.
