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

- Participants/Volunteers are requested to take care of their travel & food arrangements to the venue concerned. STARS will not provide any travel to the participants/volunteers. Whenever there is a provision for any programme concerned STARS will provide either travel or food or both and the same will be intimated to management & the students concerned well in advance.
- Participants/Volunteers are requested to maintain discipline and decorum at the place of venue & do not cause damage to individuals & things. Participants/Volunteers will not indulge in any anti social and anti national acts while supporting the programmes of STARS
- Participants/Volunteers are requested to take care of their personal belongings whenever they participate in the programme/event/educational visit of STARS including vehicles, money, mobile, books and other valuables/personal belongings. STARS will not be held responsible for loss, theft and damage.
- Participants/Volunteers are also requested to take care of their personal safety while their travel to and fro to the event either from their institution concerned/ place of residence. STARS will try to ensure safety at the venue concerned. However, STARS will NOT be held responsible for accidents while on travel to the venue or going back to institution concerned/place of residence or while executing an assignment of STARS or at the place of the event/activity/programme. No compensation (including monetary or any other) will be claimed by the institution, participant/ volunteer concerned.
- STARS will provide an annual **Letter of Appreciation** to the institution concerned subject to participation of students from institution/department concerned.
- The institution concerned/STARS may annual this agreement by sending official mail/letter. Both parties are at discretion and may or may not site reasons for the annulment of the above said agreement.

- **Internship** – Students from the college can also take up Internship ranging from one month to six months. Responsibilities as an Intern involves visiting schools to educate students on various topics like environment, health and nutrition, road safety & traffic safety and other topics including on different social issues. Extending support during the conduct of Educational Visits/Field Trips for school students and other underprivileged children. Internship also involves **Work from Home** assisting STARS in getting connected to new schools, colleges, factories/Industries, people (scientists, environmentalists, bureaucrats, subject experts, academicians etc. Certificate will be provided.
