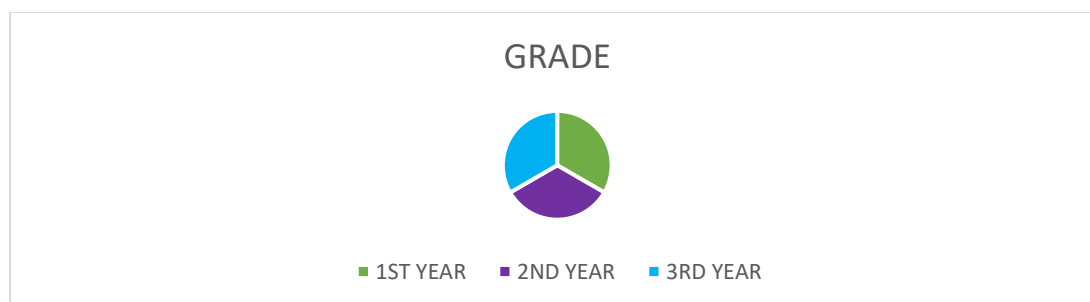
TOPIC: LANGUAGE LEARNING THROUGH READING BOOKS

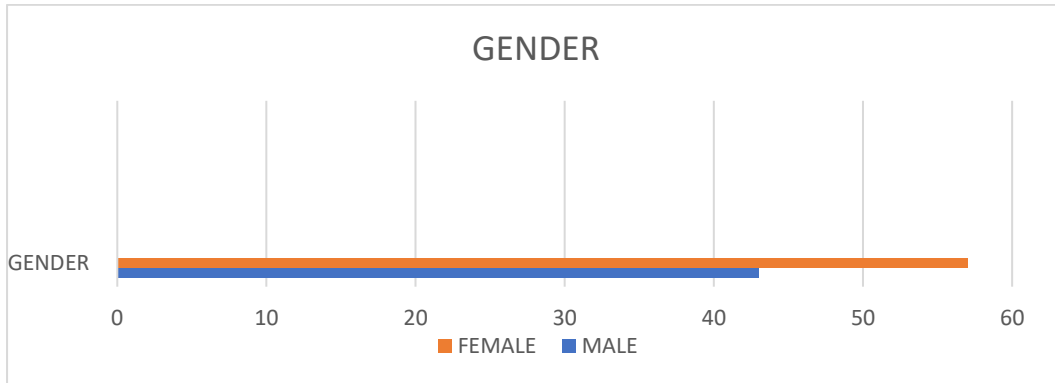
OBJECTIVES:

- reading comprehension combines the reading and thinking capacity of the learners.

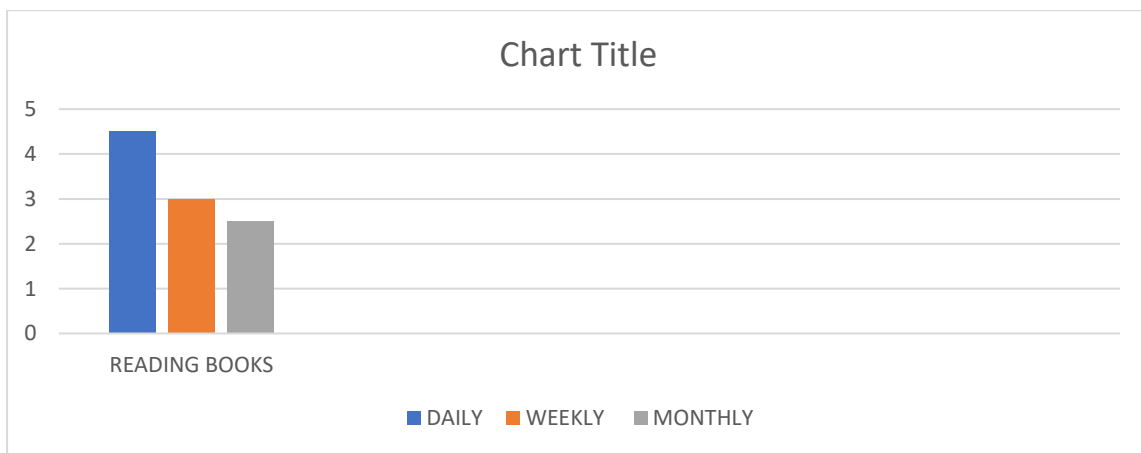

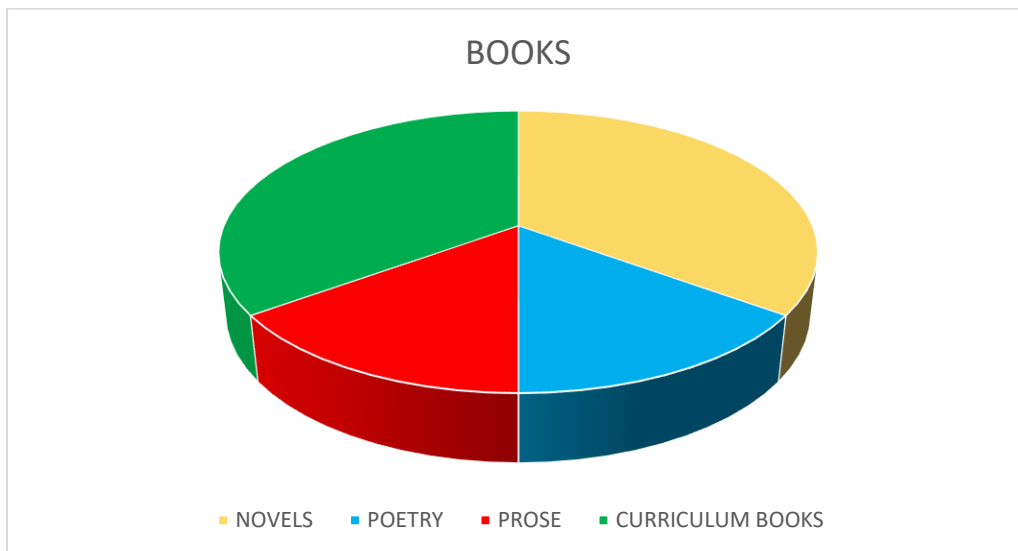

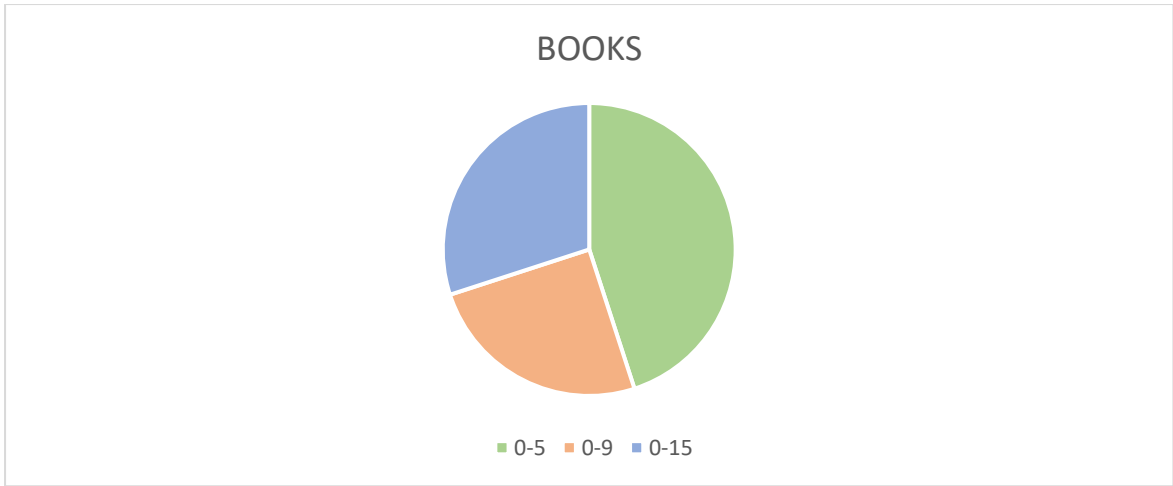

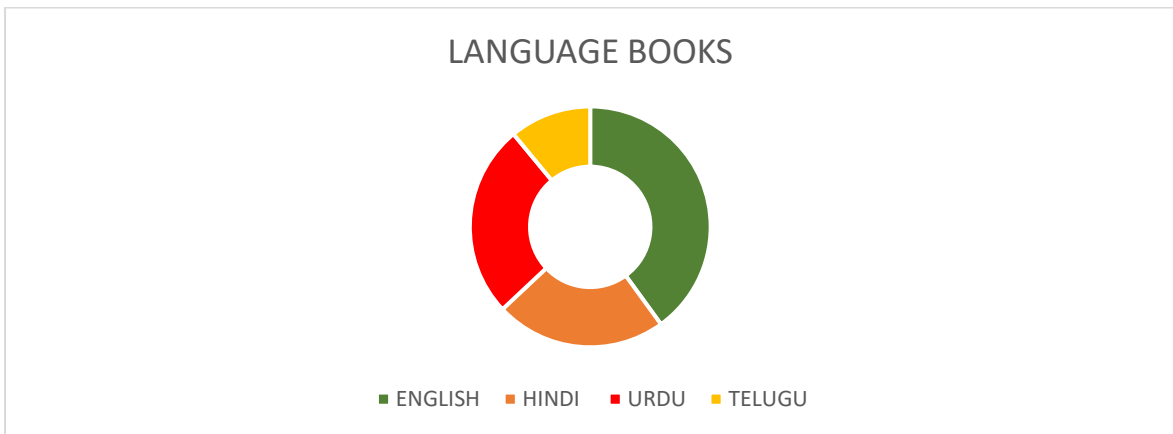

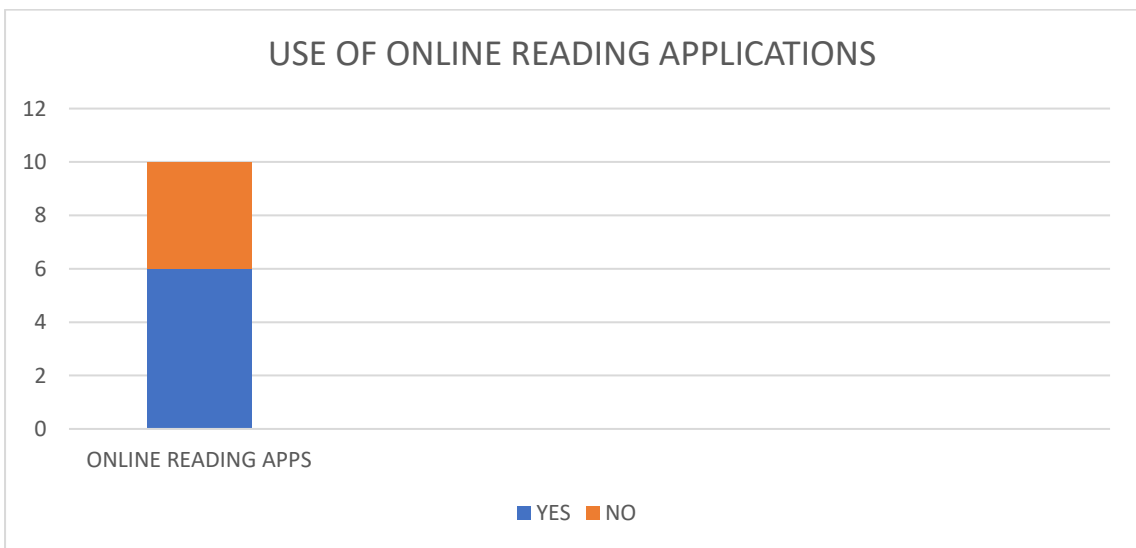

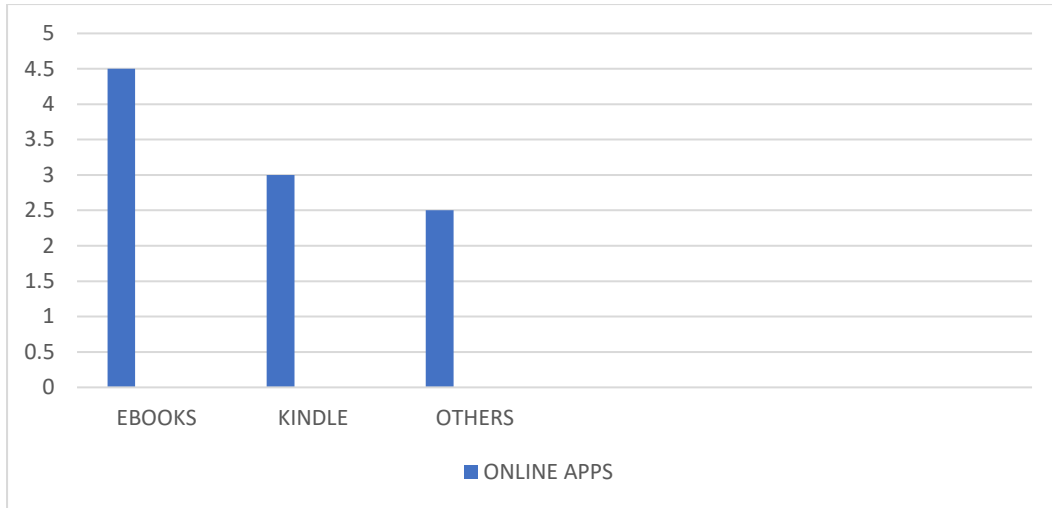
6. WHICH LANGUAGE BOOKS DO YOU READ



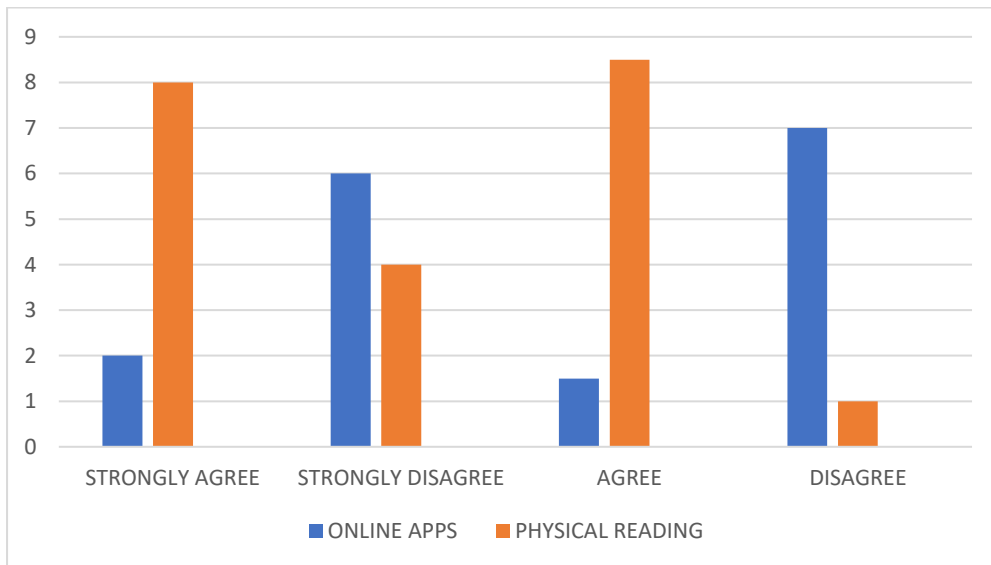
7. USE OF ONLINE READING APPLICATIONS



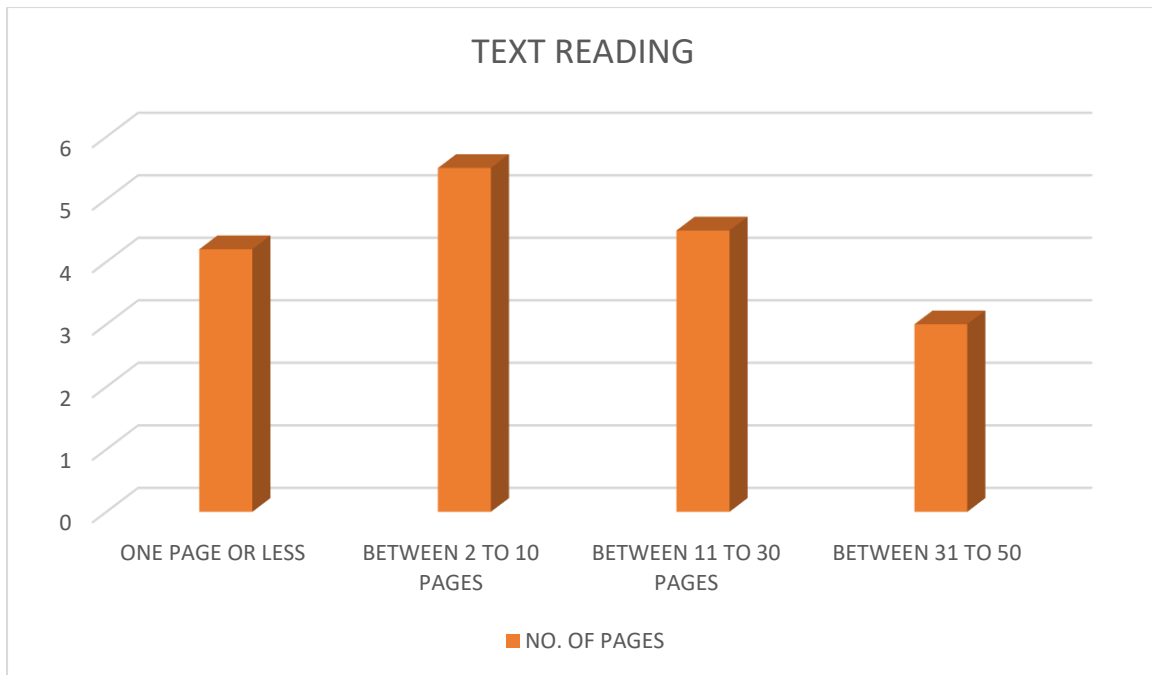
8. WHICH APPLICATIONS YOU USE
