

BEST PRACTICE 2021-2022TITLE :- GLOSSARY WRITING IN ZOOLOGY

OBJECTIVES :- The purpose of a glossary is to aid the reader in understanding terms that directly relate to a subject.

- 1) A list of key terms, along with their definitions, will help ensure that the correct terms are consistently used throughout the text.
- 2) Glossaries are a great resource for readers to rely on when learning new content.
- 3) Glossaries help distinguish between words and content-specific words.

CONTEXT :- The basic format for a glossary is a list of words in alphabetical order, each with a definition that explains what it means. Glossaries are most appropriate when the words, phrases and abbreviations used within the content relate to a specific discipline or technology area.

THE PRACTICE :-

The Practice + Using New words; using word immediately after learning, Reading everyday, Learning the roots & basis, Use a thesaurus, develop practical vocabulary, Learning new scientific terms daily, writing on blackboard and practicing; keep a book or journals for updating.


EVALUATION OF SUCCESS :- To write a glossary, students first identified the terms in the main text that need to be in the glossary. Then they created definitions for those terms and make sure the formatting of the glossary is correct so it is polished and easy to read.





Students find success with best results in the long run if followed.

PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED :- Difficulty getting started on writing. Easy distractibility during writing tasks. Inconsistent legibility in writing.

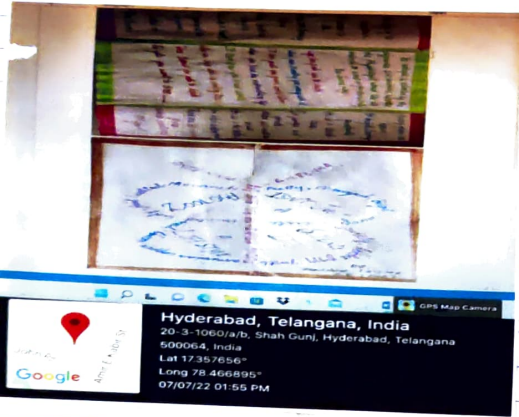
