

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "**MOU**") has been agreed, made and executed on this 17th day of January 2023"),

By and between

HEARTFULNESS EDUCATION TRUST, a Public Charitable Trust registered under The Indian Trust's Act, located at Dr.No.13-110, Kanha Village, Ranga Reddy District, Telangana (hereinafter called "HET") as First Party

And

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government Of Telangana, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad 500001(herein after known as CCETS, Hyderabad which expression shall mean and include its heir, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) representing as Second Party

(**HET** and **CCETS** shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "**Parties**" and individually referred to as "**Party**" in this MOU)

WHEREAS:

- i) **HET** is a public charitable trust registered under the Indian Trust Act, 1882 *inter alia* with an objective to impart Heartfulness approach to various wellness programmes including relaxation, meditation, value based educational programmes for schools, colleges, government organizations, corporates etc., made available to all who are willingly interested in individual development and wellbeing. HET is also engaged in conducting various Teachers' training programmes in collaboration with Certain State Governments/ Education Institutions.

ii) **Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad, Telangana (hereinafter referred to as CCETS).** The Department is created to promote Collegiate Education, giving special attention to the areas located in Backward and Rural areas, to strengthen Women education at undergraduate and post-graduate levels to create educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society and to introduce need-based vocational courses replacing the conventional courses in a phased manner.

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER

I. OBJECTIVES

The purpose of the cooperation between HET and CCETS is as follows:

Both the Parties, hereby express their commitment to collaborate with each other to conduct (i) Educational, (ii) Heartfulness relaxation, meditation and (iii) other connected wellness workshops to help students, teachers to regulate their minds, moderate their tendencies, increase their concentration, sharpen the use of their will, introspect and self-analyze and accept people and situations in general. Through such workshops and offerings of HET, they intend to help the students to improve their learning skills and behavior, and inculcate humility, emotional maturity, confidence, stress management, self-awareness and most importantly, develop a sense of purpose towards life.

- To introduce Heartful Campus Modules programmes to students and NSS Volunteers in all Government Degree Colleges of Telangana.
- To organize faculty empowerment programmes such as faculty development programmes, imparting training to NSS Programme Officers and NSS Volunteers.

II. IMPLEMENTATION

To achieve this goal, HET proposes to conduct training programmes on various aspects of Wellness, Happy Living, and Human Excellence.

HET: Is primarily responsible for designing and implementing the training sessions as and when it is required. HET will also take



the responsibility of coordination, arranging meetings, discussions and any further collaborations regarding training activities.

CCETS: Will take the responsibility of preparing training schedules and communicating the same to the internal stakeholders.

III. FACILITATORS

Both Parties shall nominate one or more representatives, who shall be the point of contact/ facilitator ("**Facilitators**") for the purposes of this MOU. The Facilitators of the respective Parties shall maintain regular contact with each other. Further, they shall propose and review the response received from the participants for the workshops and other activities that may be conducted pursuant to this MOU and in furtherance to fulfilling the purpose and objectives envisioned under this MOU.

Each party designates the persons/officers to serve as its primary contact and liaison to arrange the initial resources needed to facilitate the partnership, review, evaluate, report program activities, and address any concerns or disputes that may arise relating to the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

IV. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

This Memorandum of Understanding will be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. No modification, alteration or amendment of this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by the Parties.

Impartation of training to the students in the colleges will be free of cost and HET will not charge any cost as the HET trainers do this voluntarily as part of their social commitment towards building a better society for the youth of India. However, if the trainings arranged in HET premises, cost towards accommodation and food will be charged to the CCETS, which will be finalized as per mutual agreement.

V. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

This Memorandum of Understanding is not a contract. This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a statement of the general intention of the Parties and is not intended to be legally



binding not to be construed as an agreement on any matters mentioned. No oral agreement or conduct of the Parties (including partial performance) in respect of matters stated in this Memorandum shall be deemed to impose any obligation or liability on either Party.

This Memorandum of Understanding is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise form a joint venture, or other business entity of any kind. Neither Party shall act as an agent for, or partner of, the other Party. There are neither any rights nor obligations of the Parties established under this Memorandum of Understanding.

VI. NON EXCLUSIVITY

Although the intention of this Memorandum of Understanding is to discuss and negotiate issues with respect to a possible definitive agreement between the Parties, the relationship is non-exclusive, and the Parties shall have the ability to form similar or different relationships with other institutions or entities of their choice.

VII. COMPLIANCE

The parties agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws; ordinances, rules, and regulations; all applicable requirements of any accreditation authority, and to certify such compliance upon request.

The Parties agree to comply with all national, state, and local rules, regulations, executive orders, laws, and policies forbidding unlawful discrimination to which Institution is subject.

VIII. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION/PUBLICATION

The Parties intend to discuss with each other in connection with this Memorandum of Understanding prior to publication of any press release.

IX. VALIDITY/TERMINATION

Upon approval by each institution, this Memorandum of Understanding will remain in effect for a period of **three (3)** years unless terminated earlier by either institution. Such termination by one institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least six (6) months advance written notice of its intention to terminate. If such notice is






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given, this Agreement shall terminate: (a) at the end of such six (6) months; or (b) when all trainings enrolled in the Program at the time such notice is given have completed, whichever event occurs last. Termination will be without penalty.

Notwithstanding the above, the period of this cooperation will, if necessary, be extended with consent in writing from the Parties.

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") has been agreed, made and executed on this 17th day of January 2023.

By and between

LRR Technologies (Hyderabad) Pvt Ltd (referred to hereafter as "100pins"), located at 305, 6-3-628/9/3&4, Anand Nagar Colony, Khairatabad, Hyderabad – 500004 and represented by its Managing Director as First party

and

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government Of Telangana, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad 500001 (herein after known as CCETS, Hyderabad which expression shall mean and include its heir, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) representing as Second Party

(LRR Technologies (Hyderabad) Pvt Ltd and CCETS shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "**Parties**" and individually referred to as "**Party**" in this MOU)

Purpose

This MoU is being entered into for the following reasons:

1. Enable the development and operation of certain official web and mobile apps for the CCETS and for all the colleges under the CCETS, by 100pins, using 100pins' proprietary code, themes, hosting infrastructure and messaging engines
2. Authorize 100pins to upload the mobile apps (first version and all subsequent updates) to the Google Play Store and Apple App Store on behalf of the CCETS.

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Responsibilities and Rights of the Parties

1. 100pins will offer the services mentioned above for free of cost. Any data shared by the colleges under CCETS with 100pins, or by the users who use the web/mobile apps, will reside on the machines hosting the apps (or their backups). 100pins will be allowed by CCE to send messages of their own to the users of the web/mobile apps.
2. 100pins will create the applications, and upload them to the Google Play Store and Apple App Store through its own accounts. If CCETS would like the apps to be uploaded onto its own Play Store and Apple App Store accounts, it will need to share the credentials of such accounts with 100pins.
3. All content to be added to the apps will be the responsibility of the CCETS / the colleges under the CCETS. 100pins will merely provide a back-end content management system (CMS) to add the content.
4. CCETS will make downloading and usage of the apps built by 100pins mandatory for all the faculty, staff and colleges under it. Specifically, capturing student feedback for every class in each of the colleges under the CCETS will be made mandatory. The deadline for this will be January 31, 2023, for colleges based in Hyderabad, and February 28, 2023, for all the remaining colleges.
5. Moderation, appropriateness and legality of the content and the messages sent on the web/mobile apps will be the responsibility solely of the CCETS; 100pins is merely a technology provider. The CCETS and the colleges under it will need to abide by all the terms of using the 100pins services posted on the 100pins.com website, which will hold in case of any differences or disputes, and which may be revised from time to time.
6. Both Parties reserve the right to withdraw from this MoU at any time.

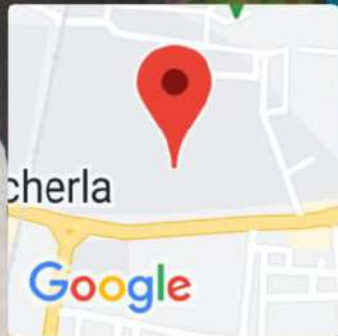
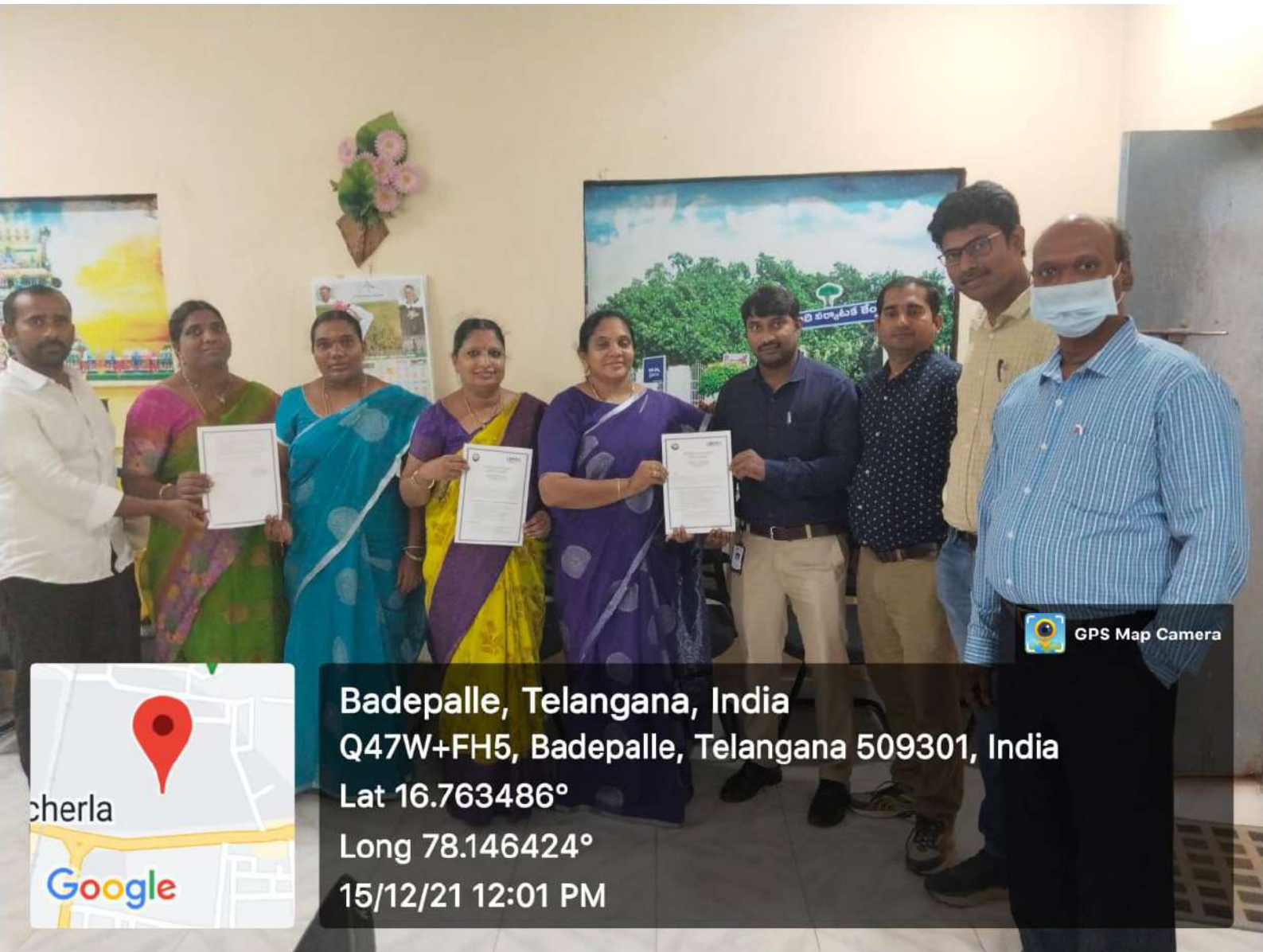

- B. The parties to the memorandum may, by mutual consent add, modify, amend, delete review any items and conditions of this agreement.
- C. The intent and implementation of this memorandum is subject to the policies, rules and regulations of the respective institutions.
- D. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of 3 years from the date of its signature and seal and may be terminated by either side by giving a one month notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
- E. The parties to this MOU undertake to treat as confidential and privileged information of the other institution which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as mutually acceptable terms. This MOU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/ executive body of both the institutions.

Memorandum of Agreement

This Memorandum of Agreement is made between

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS)

and

Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay (ST- IIT Bombay)

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education is created to promote quality education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It also strengthens the women education at undergraduate level and works towards educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society.

The Spoken Tutorial project developed by IIT Bombay for MHRD, Government of India is the initiative of the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (ICT), launched by the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India. The uses of spoken tutorial is to advocate and popularize numerous Open Source software and their utilization.

Spoken tutorial project intends to provide opportunity to conduct software training from ST-IIT Bombay to all the Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) in Telangana state. As the programme is funded by the National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD, Government of India it charges a nominal annual User Fee of Rs.25000/year/college. The program will provide the following benefits to the students of GDCs under purview of CCETS-

1. Students and Teachers receive hands on training through a particular FOSS (Free and Open Source Software) like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHP & MySQL, Java, C/C++, Libre Office etc. The students who complete the required training hours will be awarded Certificates by Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay.
2. The training enhances IT, Software skills and employability for the students and any number of students and faculty can take any number of courses and Certificates in a year with User Fee of Rs. 25000/year/college.

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), Telangana State and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay does hereby agree to the following broad terms of cooperation as under:

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education shall-

- Identify a Chief Central Co-ordinator from the department who will actively work and co-ordinate with Spoken Tutorial team, IIT Bombay to roll-out and introduce the project into all degree colleges in the state.
- Put up the signed agreement note on the CCE website along with Spoken Tutorial site link and Telangana training manager Ms. Swati Dongardive's contact details and issue notifications to all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges to make the Payment through NEFT, introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in colleges.
- Conduct a Master training program for a faculty member in each GDC through Faculty Development Training Program for running Software training SELF learning way in their respective Colleges as one of the initiatives under capacity building.
- Offer General IT Skills package in Telugu also.
- Issue circular to all the GDCs to introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in the GDCs.
- Have a monitoring system on department's website ccets.cgg.gov.in to track the progress made by the different colleges, suggest bi-monthly reports from colleges to CCE and ST, IIT Bombay.

The Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay shall-

- Work as a mentor for the GDCs in the Telangana State.
- Support the training and execution by CCE by providing manuals and continuous guidance at the unit level that is the Government Degree College.
- Nominate a Representative who will work with the Faculty Development Training Program in CCE.

- Provide guidance and learning path for progressively higher levels of learning through advanced courses.
- Provide the knowhow and course content material that includes CDs/DVDs, online material, instruction sheets and any other training material related to the GDCs.
- Issues Completion Certificates, who undergo training and qualifies the Online assessment test
- Participation Certificates shall be issued to the students who undergo the training and do not take the online test.
- Provide the promotional materials like posters, brochures, leaflets, banners etc. to the CCETS and the GDCs in TS.


General

- This agreement is for a duration of one year from the date of signing and can be renewed and modified from time to time if necessary, based on mutual consent.
- IIT Bombay-ST permits the colleges with less than 100 number of students to learn along with nearby college students and will not expect the User Fee of Rs.25000/college/year.
- The interpretation of any clause will rest with CCE TS.

Now based on the above mentioned promise(s), the parties put their signatures on this MoA on 19.02.2019.

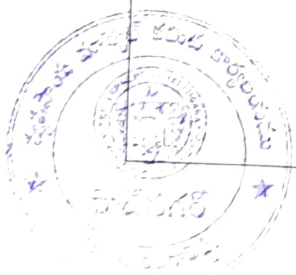

- D. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of 5 years from the date of its signature and seal and may be terminated by either side by giving a one month notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
- E. The parties to this MOU undertake to treat as confidential and privileged information of the other institution which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as mutually acceptable terms. This MOU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/ executive body of both the institutions.
