- Citrus fruits can be separated into those with soluble and others with insoluble constituents, based on 80% ethanol extraction.
- The insoluble solid portion in 80% ethanol yields polysaccharides upon further extractions.
- Total nitrogen content is between 0.08% and 0.11% in oranges, 0.08% in grapefruit, and 0.06% in lemons.
- With little seasonal variation observed in free amino acid concentration, nonessential amino acids such as alanine, arginine, asparagine, aspartic acid, glutamic acid, glycine, serine, and proline are found in several orange, lemon, and mandarin varieties, whereas indispensable amino acids, such as valine, phenylalanine, threonine, leucine, methionine, and lysine, are reported in certain oranges and grapefruit.

Use of Medicinal Plants for COVID-19 by Indigenous people- A case study in Eturnagaram reserve forest.

ABSTRACT

Introduction:

Medicinal plants and ethno medicinal studies continue playing a significant role in development of preventive medicine and also to conserve the traditional knowledge. In the wake of Covid-19 there is an increased demand for effective homemade preventive medicine apart from the vaccines and allopathic medicines. Therefore, ethno medicinal studies have increased recently to unleash the potential in medicinal plants and document verbal traditional knowledge. When we are comparative statistical data with other urban areas population least of positive cases are reduced in this tribal area of eturnagaram reserve forest. This study recorded the medicinal plants administered by traditional practitioners during covid-19 in the Tribal area of Eturnagaram district in Telangana

Methodology: This study was conducted for one week in September 2021 along with our project teammates and Botany assistant professor Dr.ghan singh sir. Semi-structured questionnaires were administered to traditional medicine practitioners by the students of GDC Eturnagaram. Data collected included of different medicinal plant species and plant local names, medicinal uses, parts used, preparation methods and administration methods from the tribal people and traditional practitioners. Some species were photographed and identified in the field by the faculty and use of Plant identifier App.

Results: Three traditional practitioners and 10 inhabitants were randomly interviewed. And collected data with questionnaires. Thirteen medicinal plant species belonging to 8 different families were used as prophylaxis for Covid -19 and other respiratory diseases and cold cough also fever. Preparation methods ranged from infusion to cream. Of these, 85% were administered orally. Roots and Leaves were the most used part while the least used was flowers.

Conclusion: The Eturnagaram reserve forest area has a rich biodiversity of different medicinal plant species belongs to different family members. It has wonderful source for young scientists and researchers for knowledge in medicinal plants and their medicinal values, scientists can use as a baseline for identification of plant species, bioactive compounds and preparations with useful medicinal properties.

INTRUDUCTION

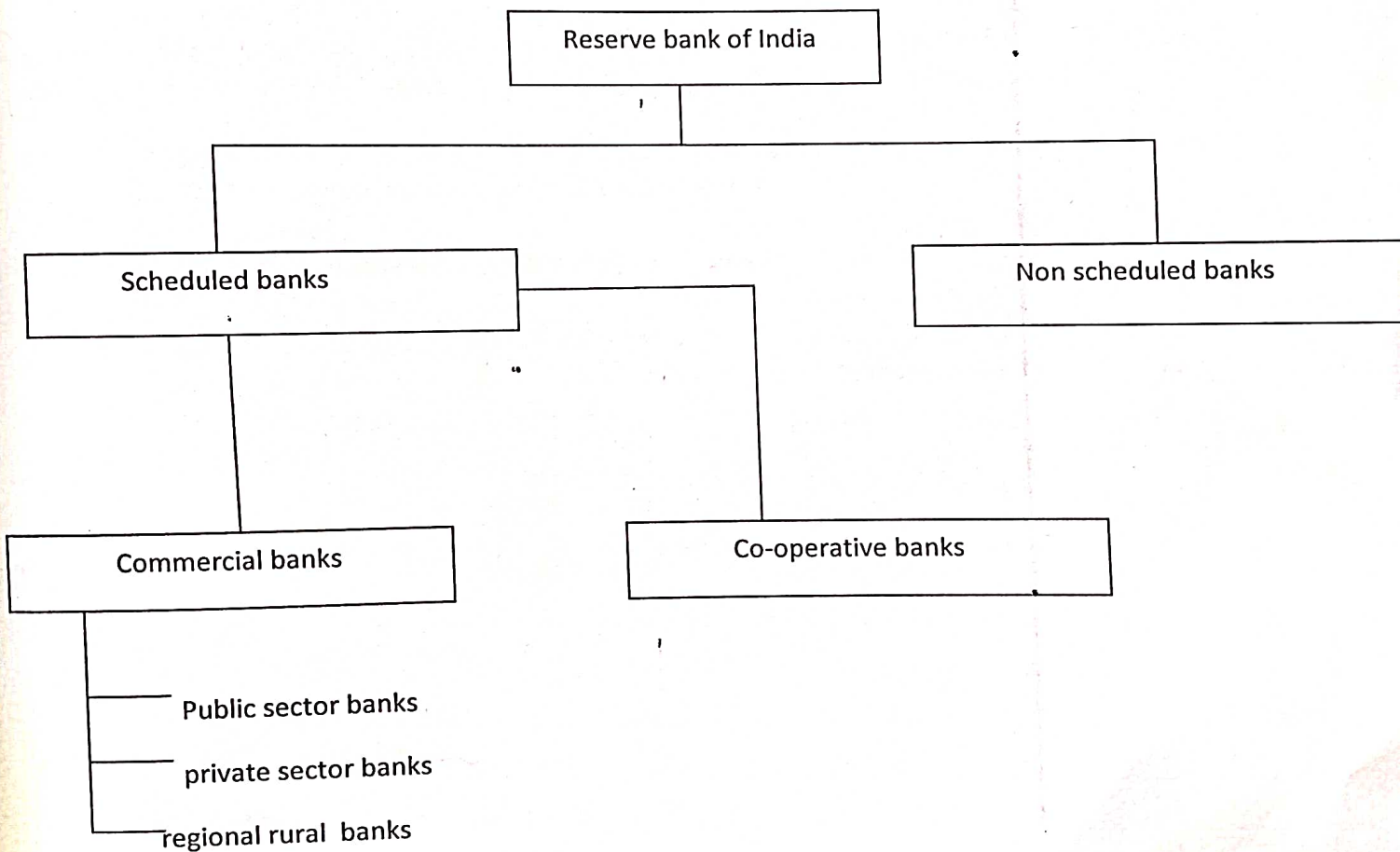
The Indian banking system when the nation became independent in the year 1947, Indian banking was wholly in the private sector, mostly in urban areas .The imperial bank of India was taken over by the government through the state bank of India, Act 1955.

1969 nationalization of 14 banks with deposit of qver 50 crores, in order to reduce regional imbalance of economic activities. To make banking system reach in hand of rural and semi-urban people in 1980, six more banks were nationalized.

Narasimham committee reports in 1991,1988 these reports made certain recommendations for introducing radical measures

Banking companies Act 1949, defines banking as “accepting for the purposes of lending or investment, deposits of money from the public repayable on demand or otherwise and withdrawal by cheques, drafts, orders etc”.

BANKING SECTOR REFORMS

- The Reserve Bank initiated a number of measures of the creation of competitive environment.
- Deregulation of interest rates had begun in 1980 onwards
- Earlier changes were politically induced, whereas, the present ones are market driven
- In order to control high transaction cost, poor customer service, outdated work technology, low productivity and efficiency thereby eroding the profitability made several banks financially weak
- The recommendations of the Narasimham committee – I in 1991 provide the blue print for the foundations for reforms in the banking system

Asset liability management helps in proper planning, directing, controlling the flow, level, mix and rates on the assets and liabilities can be made with changing scenarios.

- The banking business involves identifying, measuring, accepting and managing the risk, the key banks financial management is risk management

- A bank has an obligation to pay the liabilities when demanded, but cannot liquidate the same quantum of assets as certain intrinsic conditions are built in them similarly.

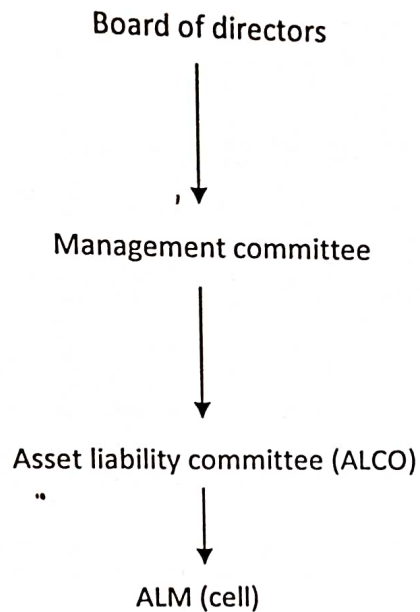
