




TOPIC: Coral-polytp: * The coral polytp. is similar to a sea-anemone.
 * The coral polytp are solitary or colonial form.
 * The coral polytp has a mouth, tentacles, stomach and mesenteries.
 * During the formation of coral first of all, a basal plate is secreted between the base of the polytp and the substratum.
 * The outer edges of septa fuse together to form them.
 * Thousands of such corallites fuse together to form a large coral-stone called corallum.


