The founder of the college and of several other educational institutions in the Hyderabad state, was Syed Husain Bilgrami who did pioneering work in the field of education as the Director Education.

This college is an autonomous, constituent college of a Osmania University. It is located near Lal Bahadur Shastri Stadium in Hyderabad. Nizam college was originally a place of Fakhru-ol-Mulk II. noble of Hyderabad.

Nizam college celebrated its centenary in 1987. It was established in 1887 by the amalgamation of the Hyderabad school (Nobel school) and Madarsa- Aliya. Initially it was affiliated to the University of Madras for 60 years and was made a constituent college of Osmania University on 19 February 1947.
