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## REPORT

The department of English felt that an Orientation Programme would help the English Lecturers to be oriented in this regard.

Then the department placed a proposal to the principal of the college to accord permission to conduct such programme. Aptly the principal madam accepted the proposal and forwarded the same to the hon'ble commissioner, Collegiate Education- Telangana. By identifying the need of such a programme of the hour the hon'ble commissioner, Collegiate Education- Telangana, immediately accorded the permission through the File No. CCE-A/AF/72/2020-ACADEMIC CELL dated: 28-12-2021 to organise the programme by utilizing an amount of Rs, 24,500/- (Rupees Twenty Four Thousand Five Hundred only) out of accumulation funds of the college by granting On Duty to the participants.

Next the department approached the course editors and the course writers of the new syllabi to provide orientation on the new syllabus to the English Lecturers. They immediately accepted our request and on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2022, Prof. C. Murali Krishna and Prof. Y.L. Srinivas of Osmania University, Hyderabad threw a broad light on the new text books on online mode. Around 64 English Lecturers took part in the programme. ## What's the Language of the Future?

(Extract)

No language has spread as widely as English, and it continues to spread. Internationally the desire to learn it is insatiable. In the twenty-first century the world is becoming more urban and more middle class, and the adoption of English is a symptom of this, for increasingly, English serves as the lingua franca of business and popular culture. It is dominant or at least very prominent in other areas such as shipping, diplomacy, computing, medicine and education. A recent study has suggested that among students in the United Arab Emirates "Arabic is associated with tradition, home, religion, culture, school, arts and social sciences," whereas English "is symbolic of modernity, work, higher education, commerce, economics and science and technology." In Arabic-speaking countries, science subjects are often taught in English because excellent textbooks and other educational resources are readily available in English. This is not something that has come about in an unpurposed fashion; the propagation of English is an industry, not a happy accident.
